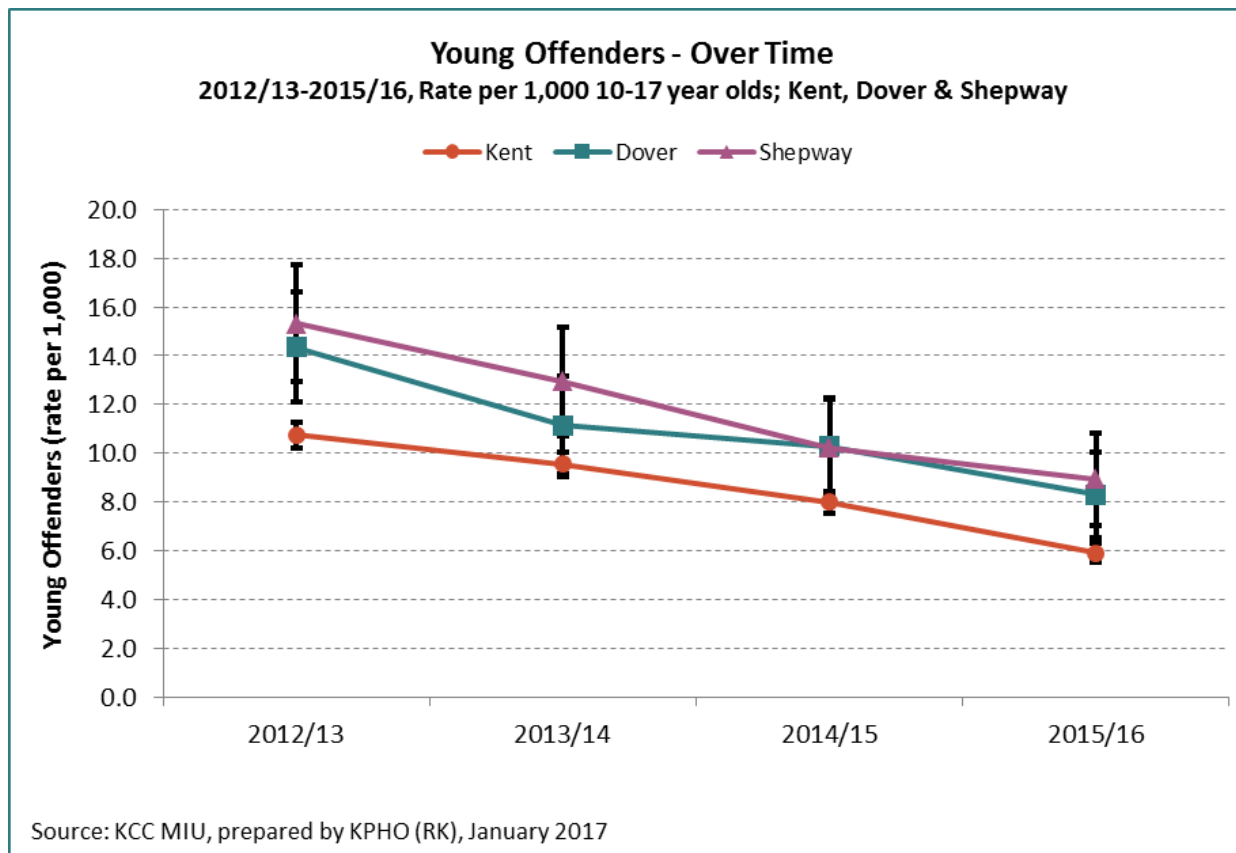

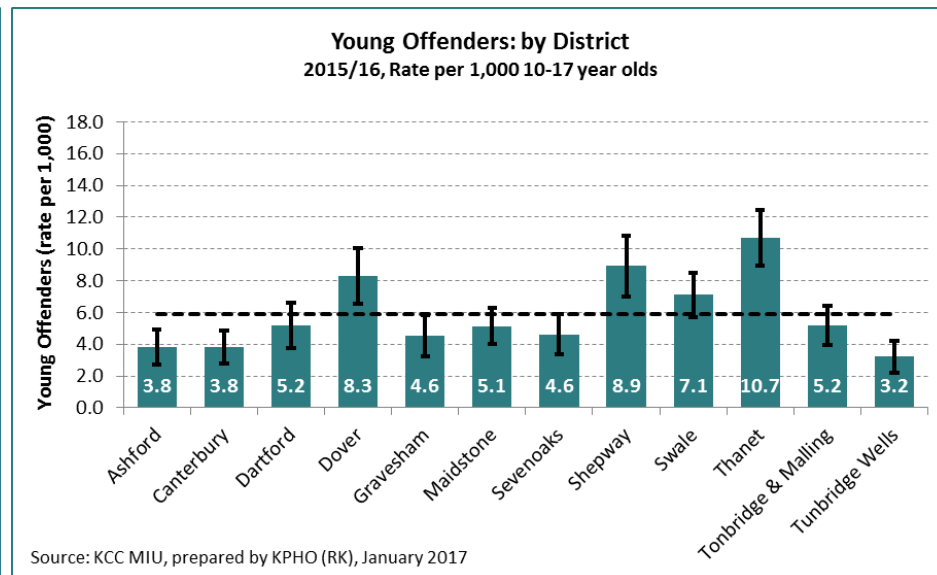

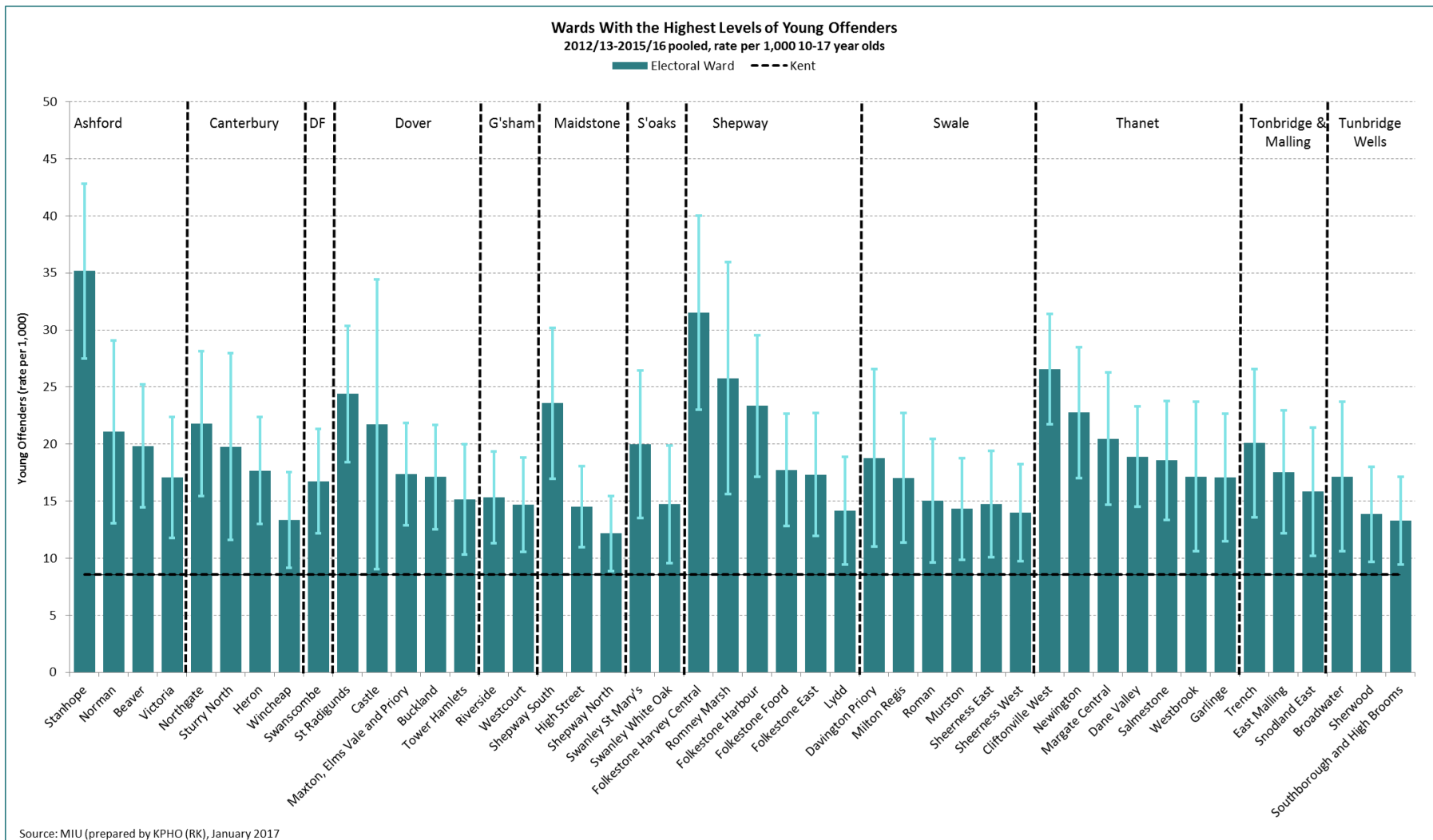

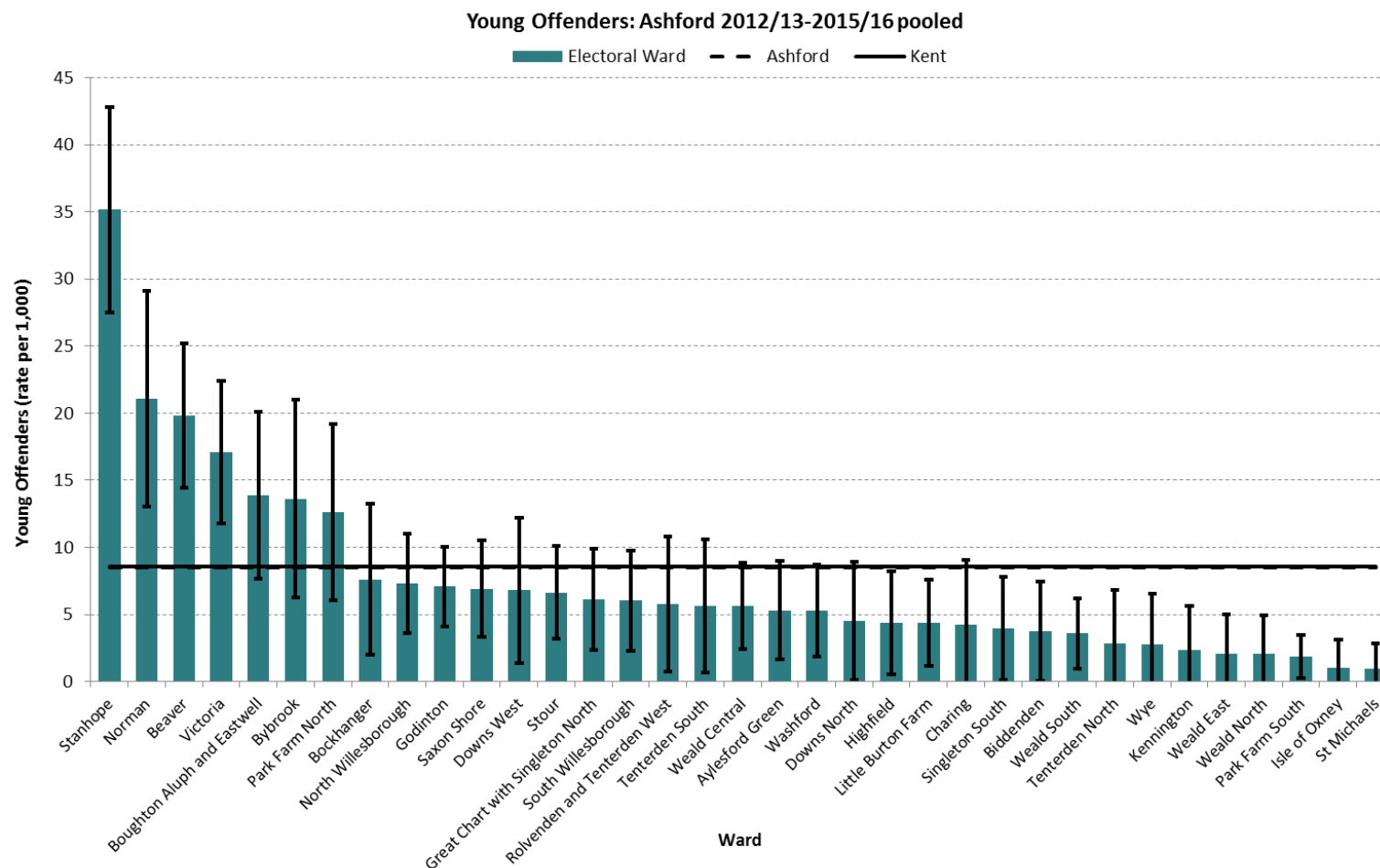

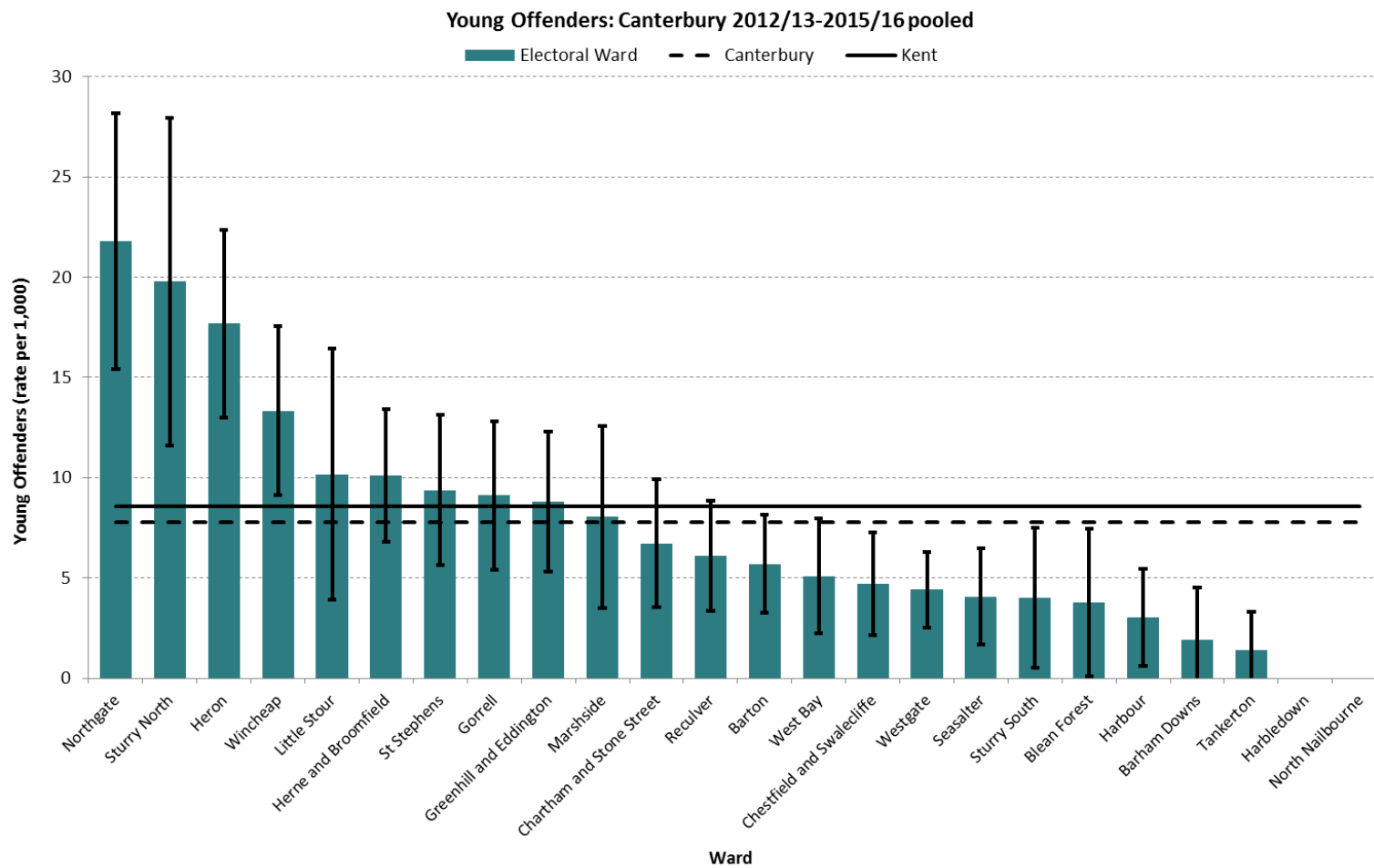

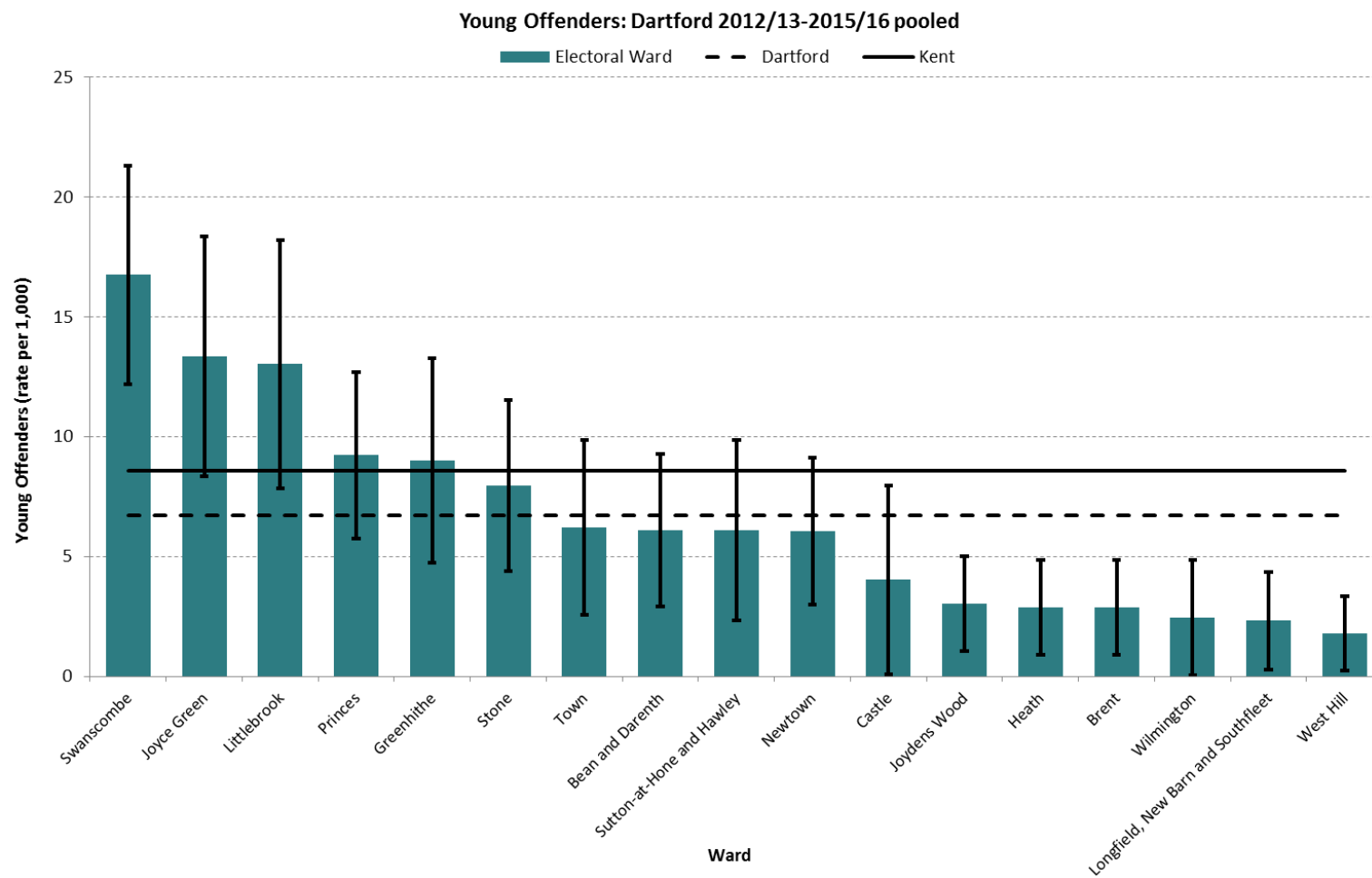

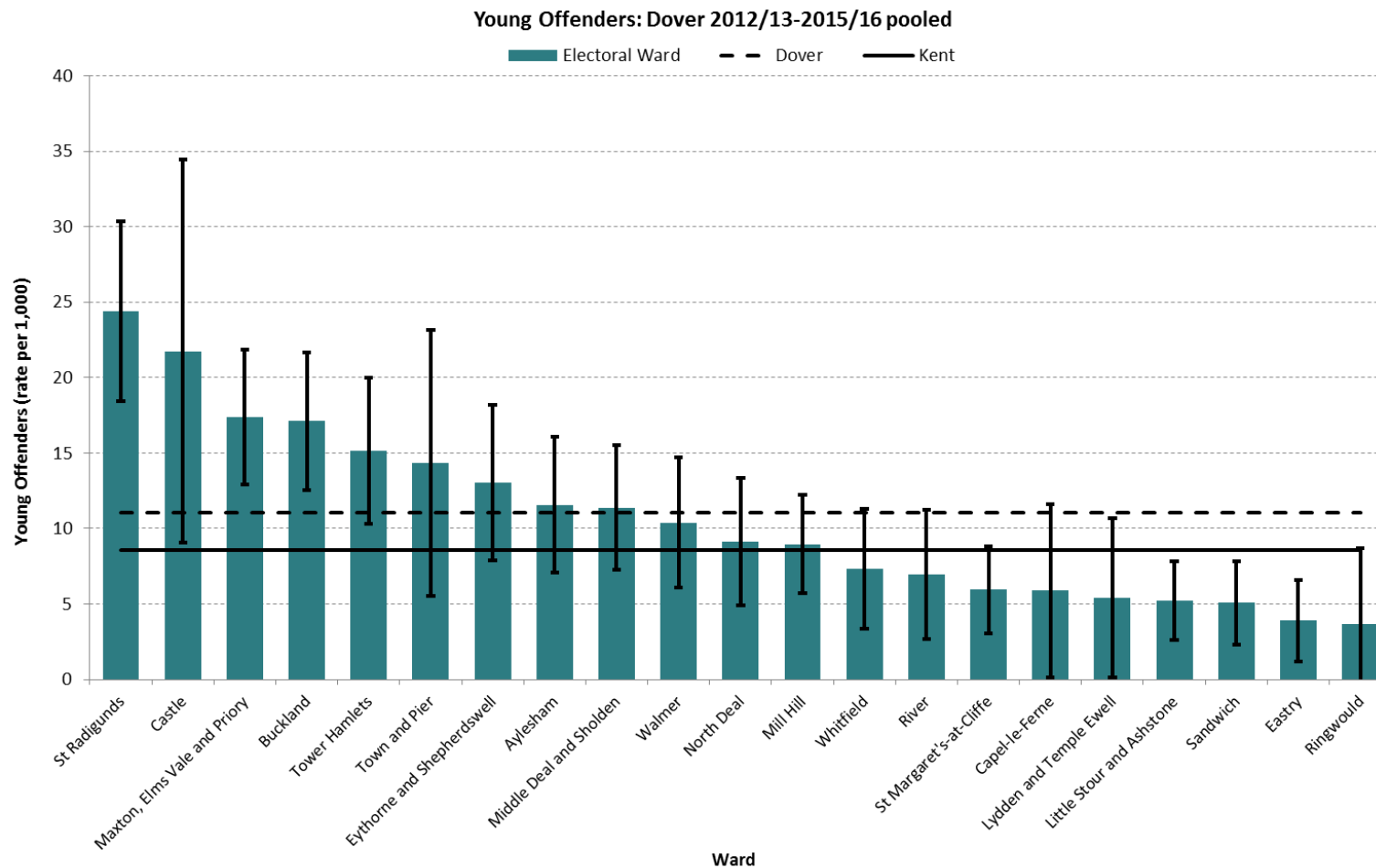

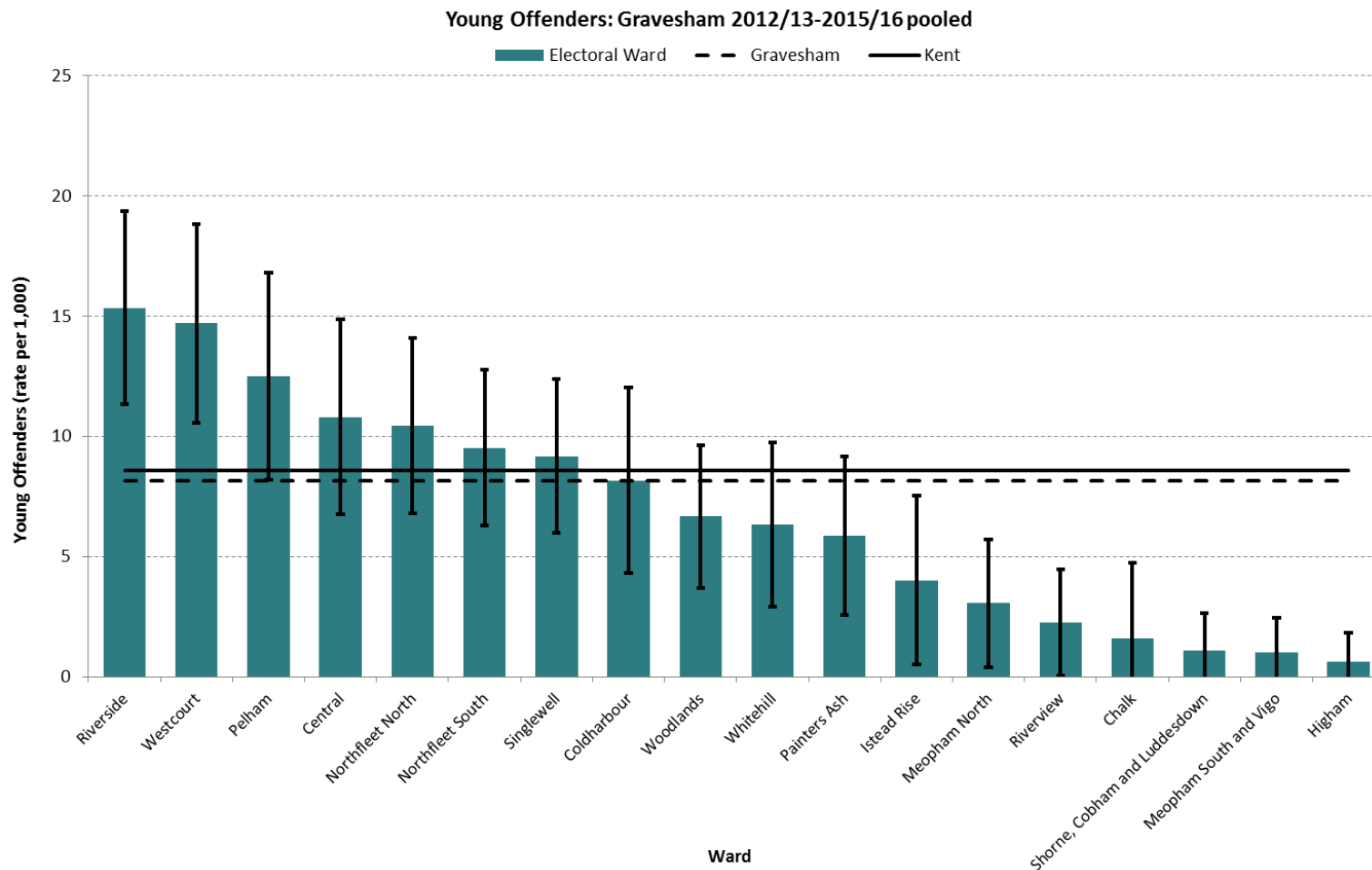

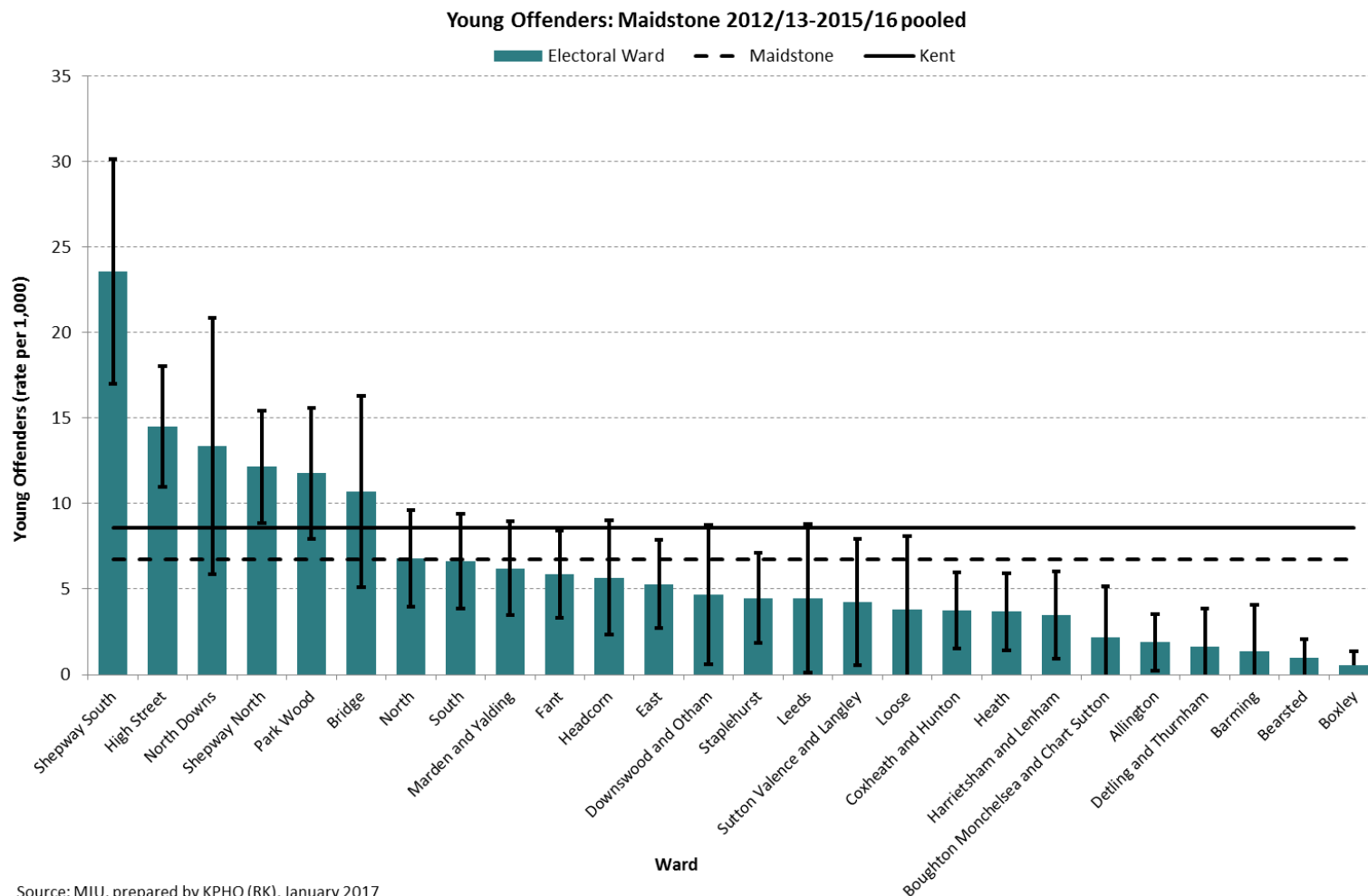

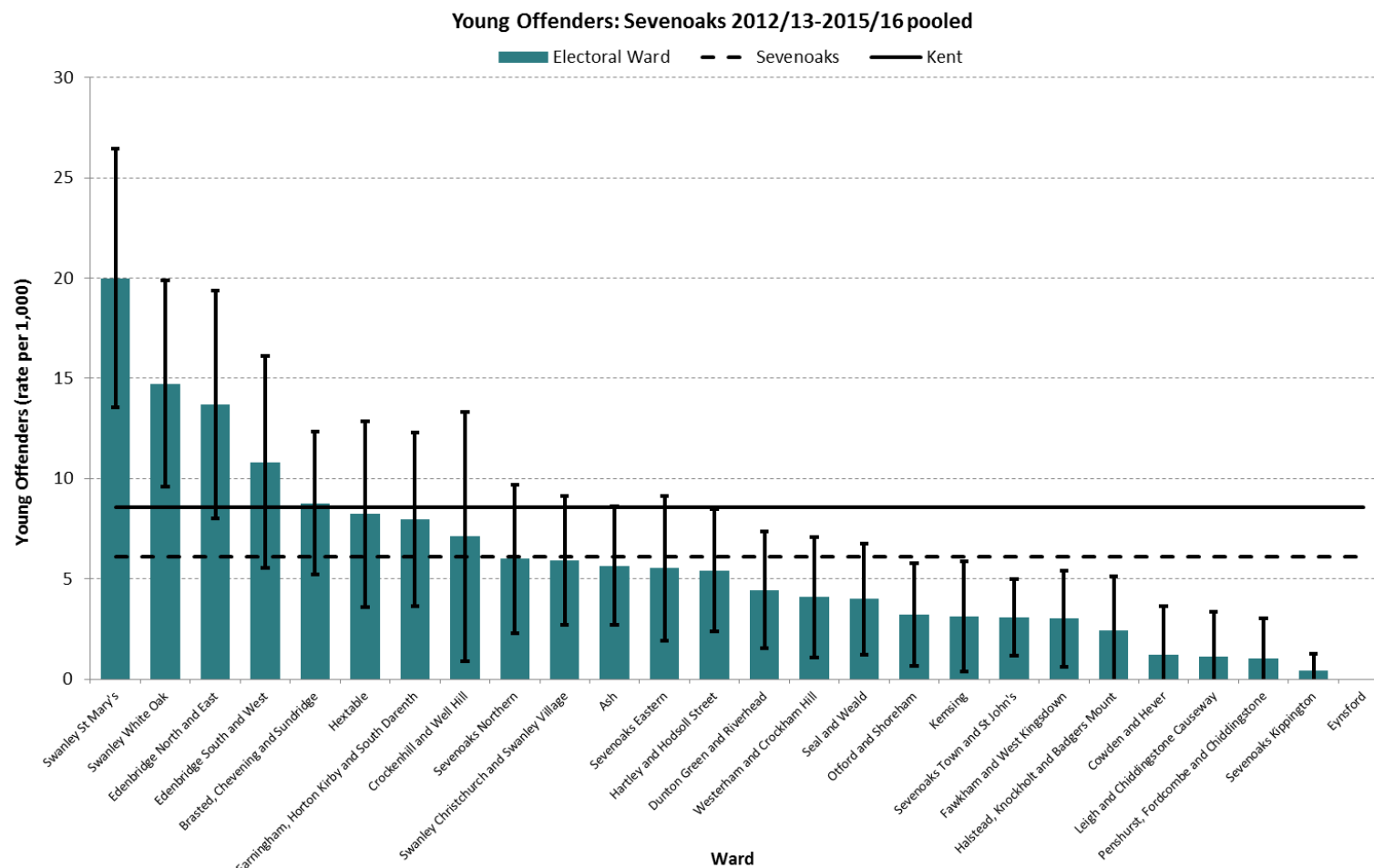

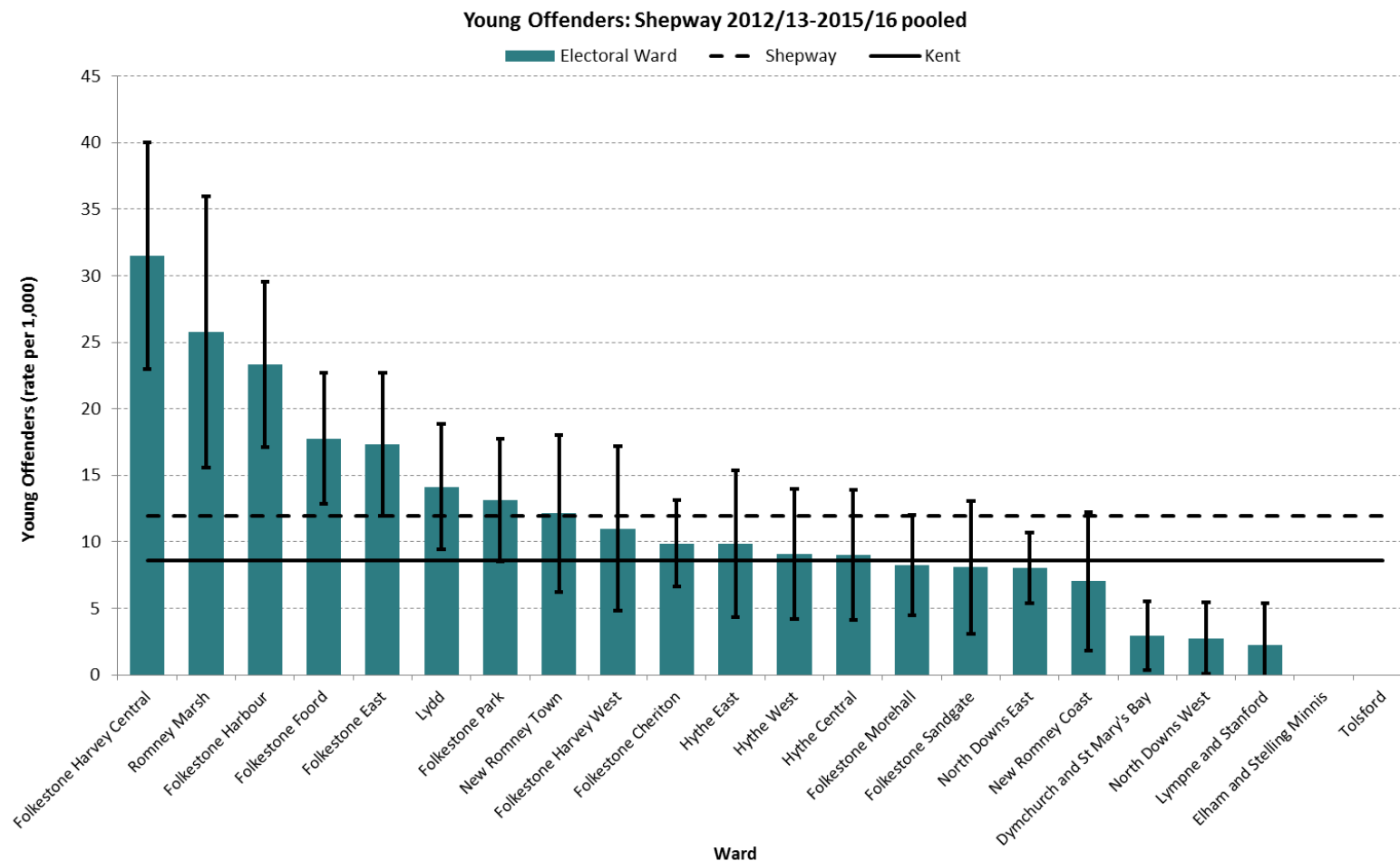

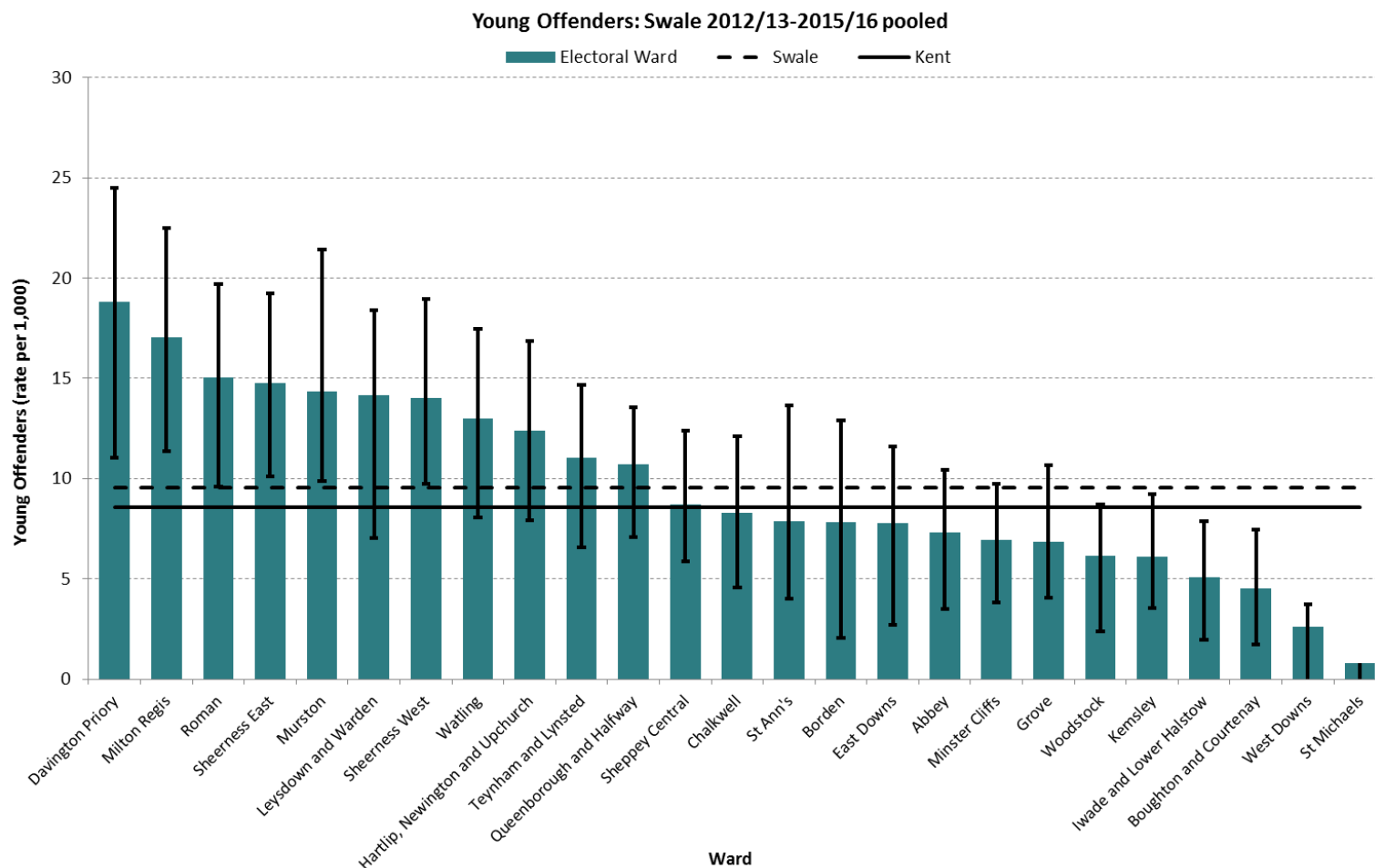

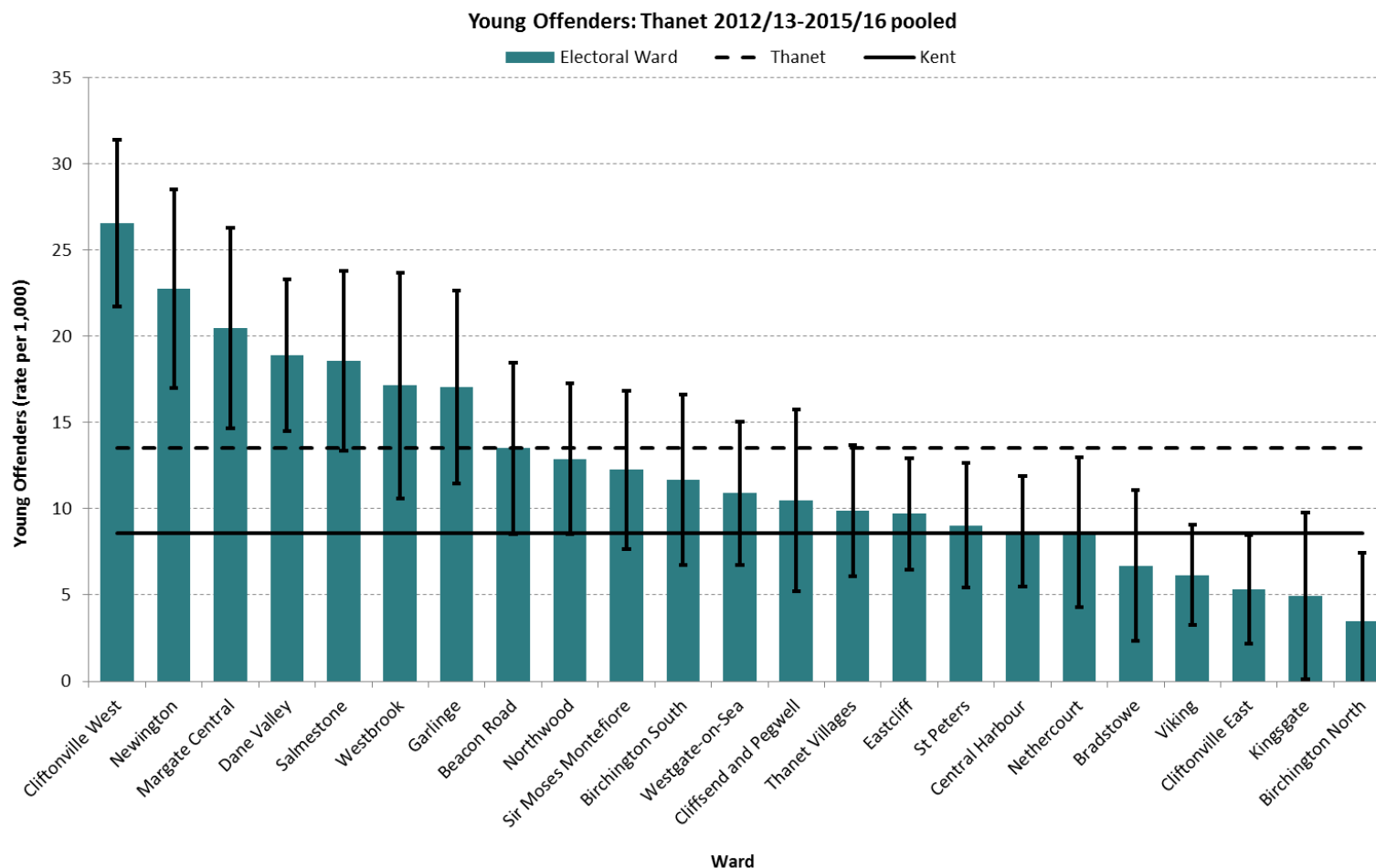

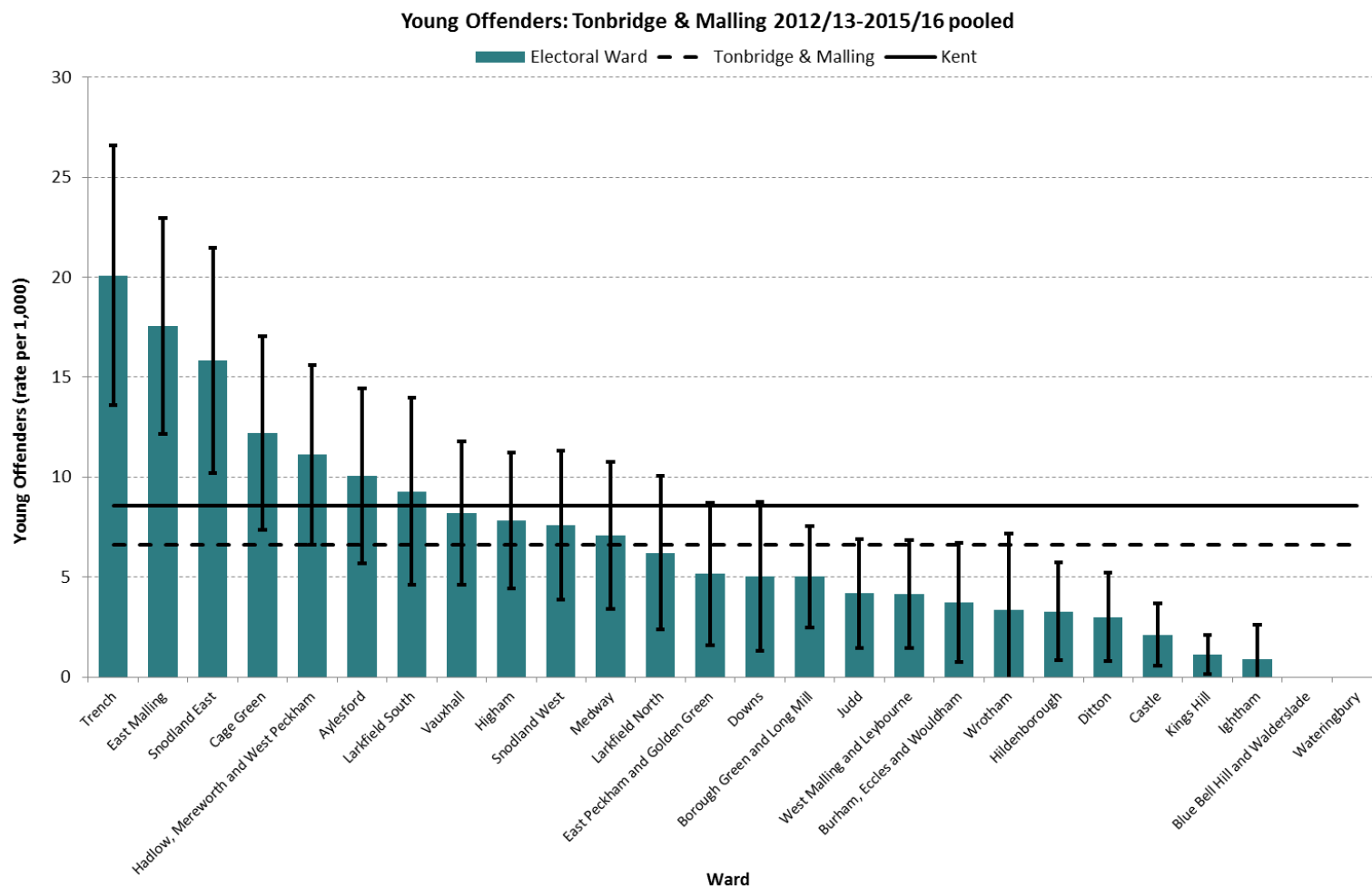

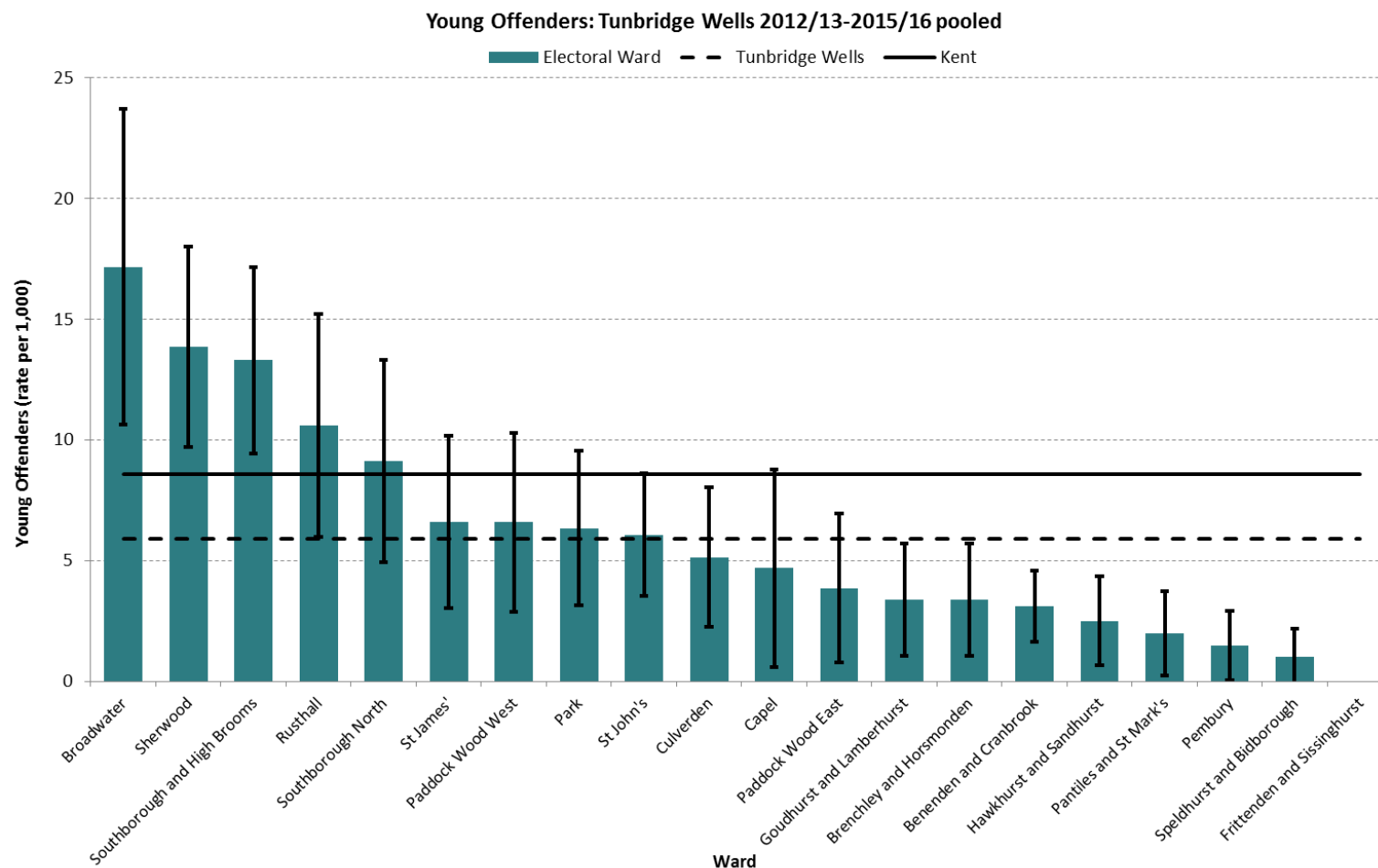

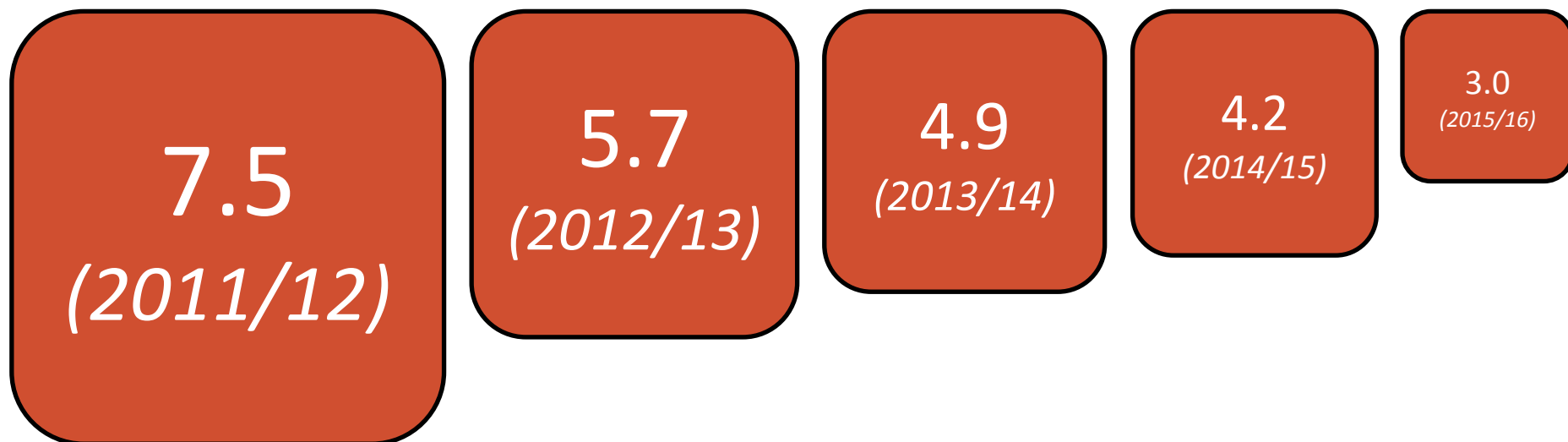

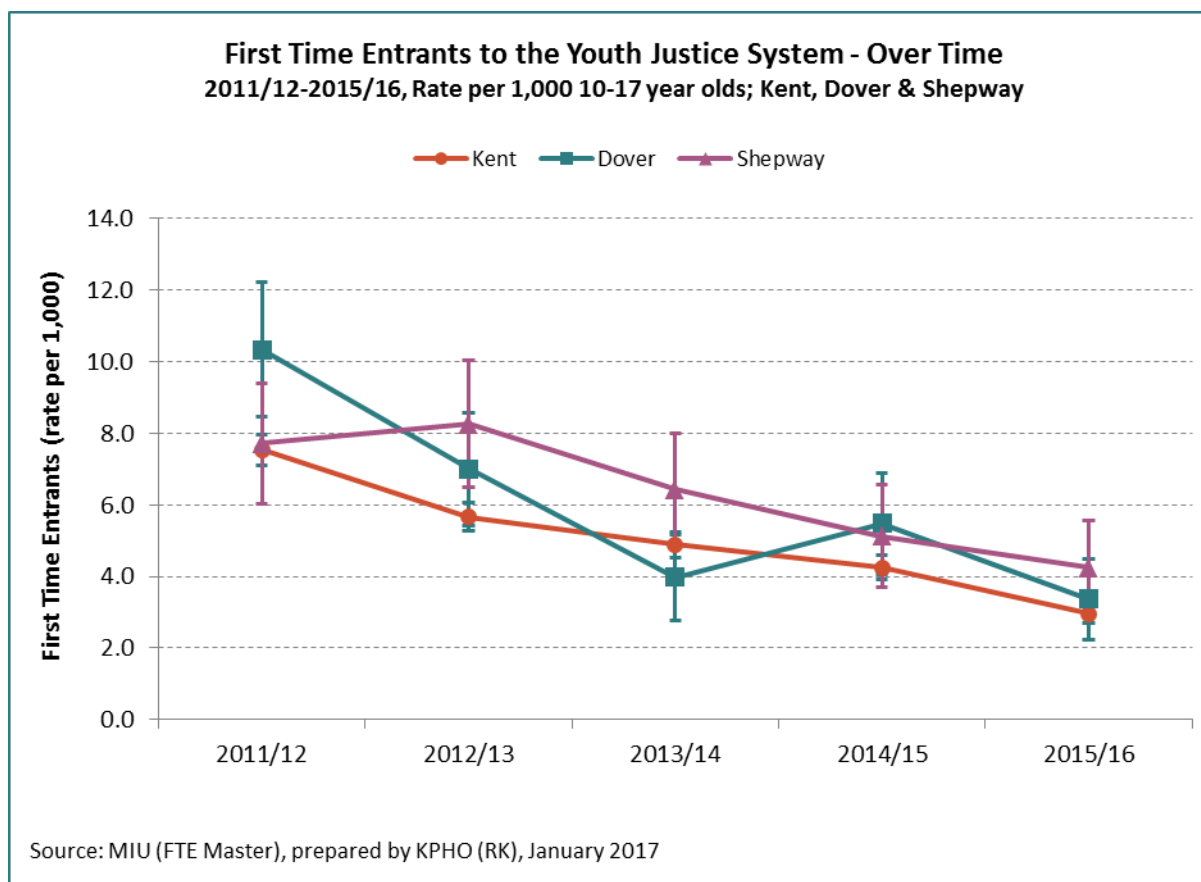

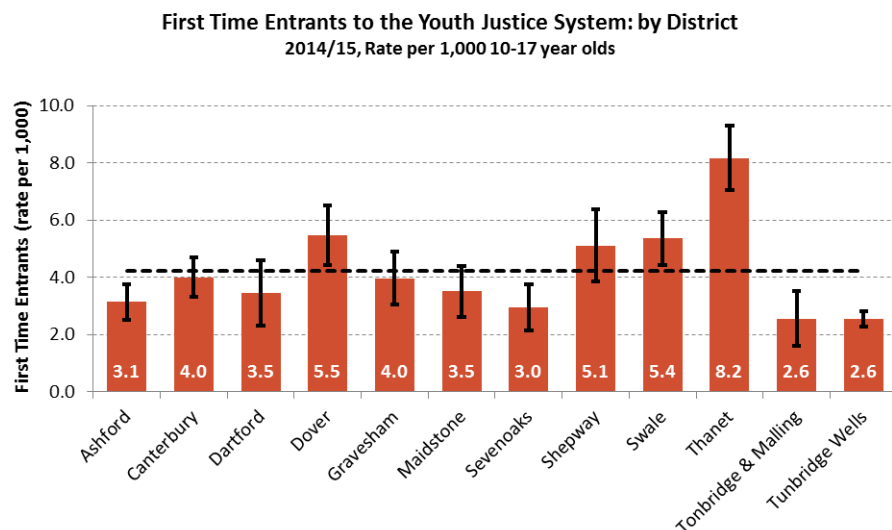

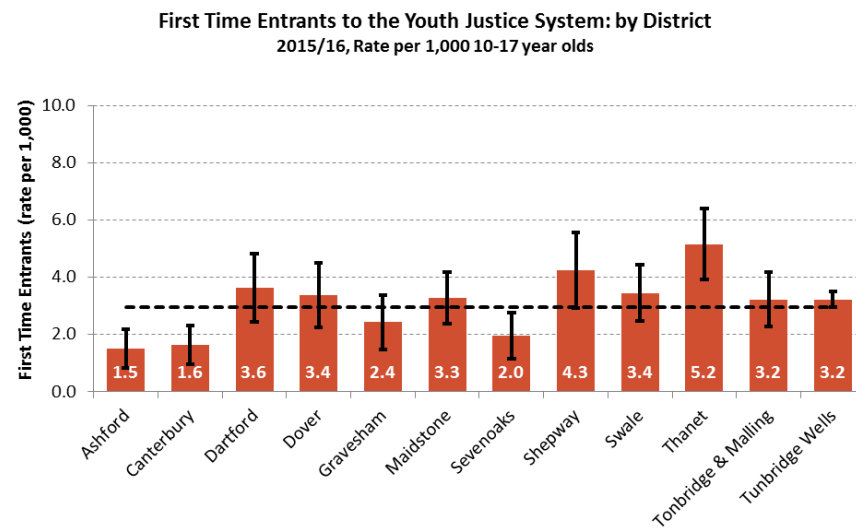
First Time Entrants – By District

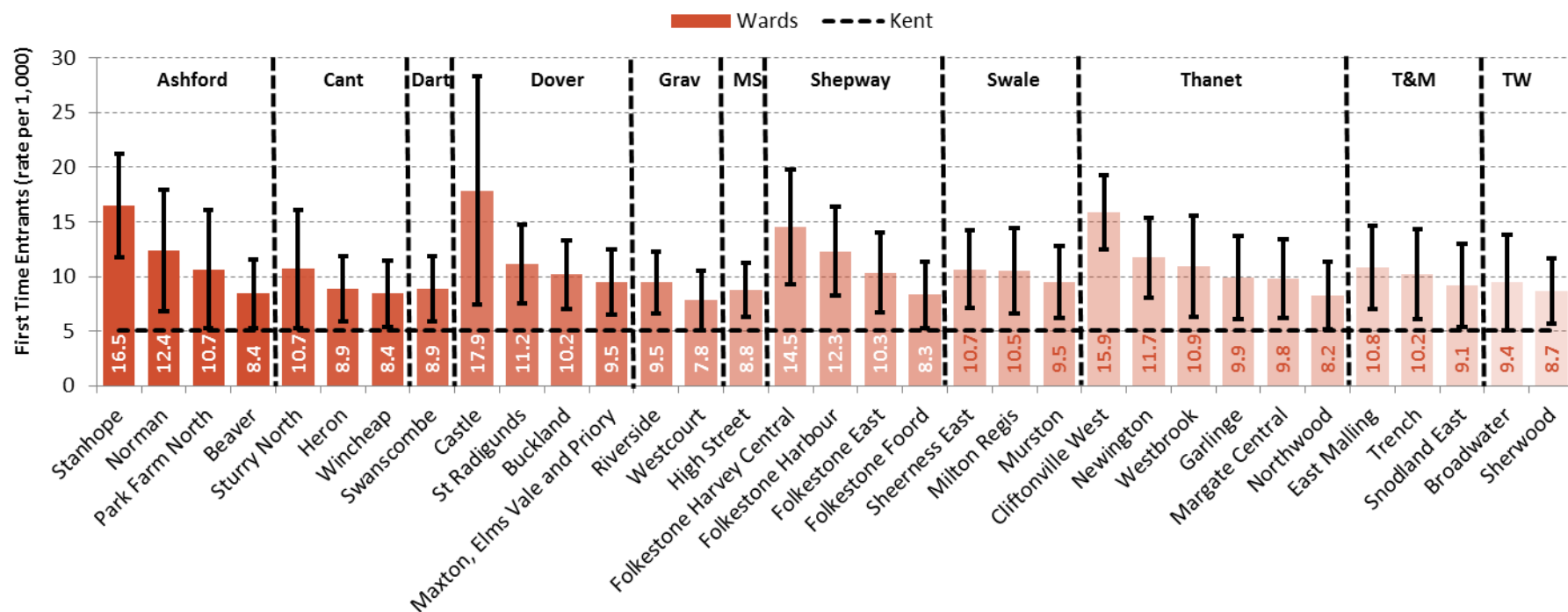

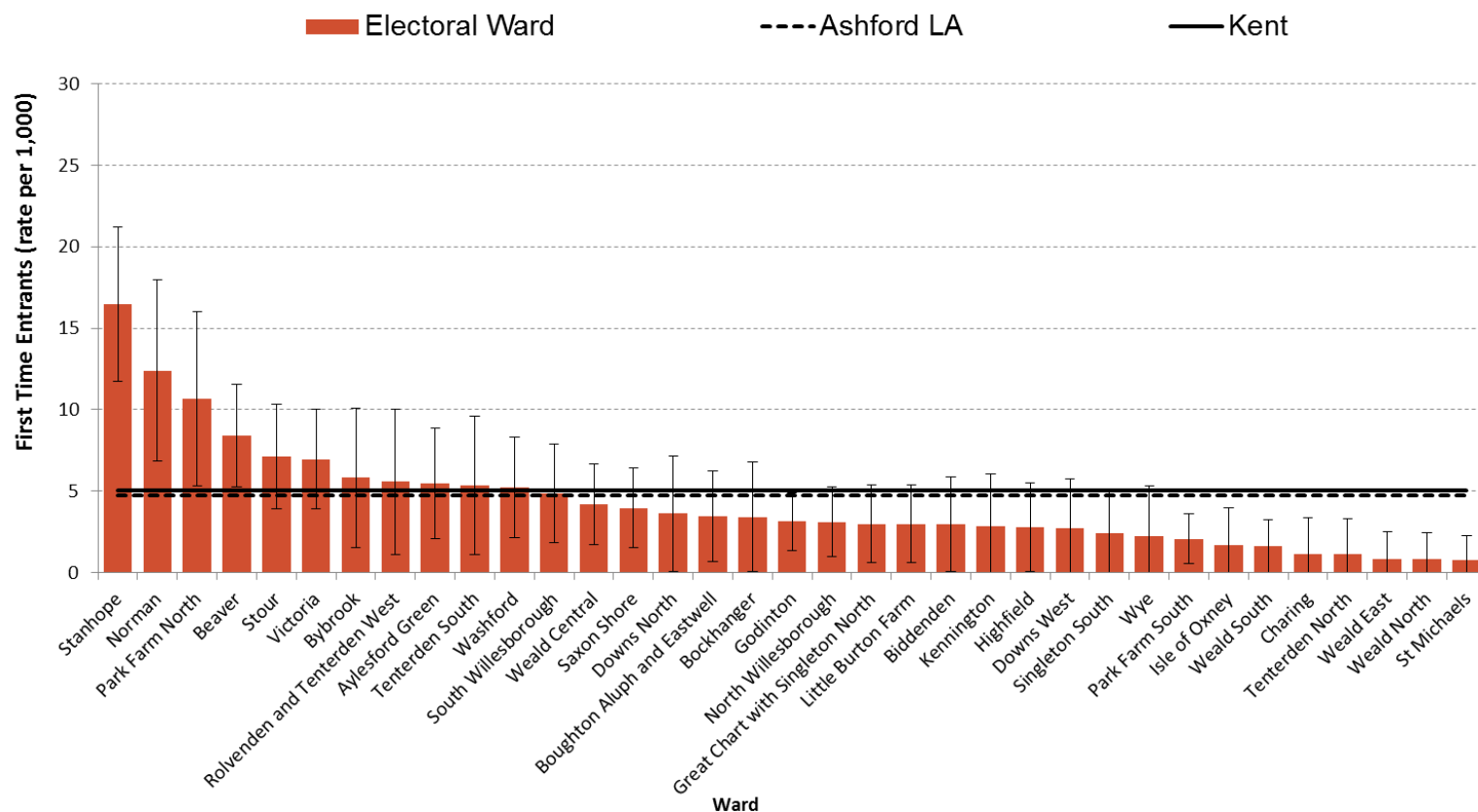
Wards With the Highest Levels of First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System

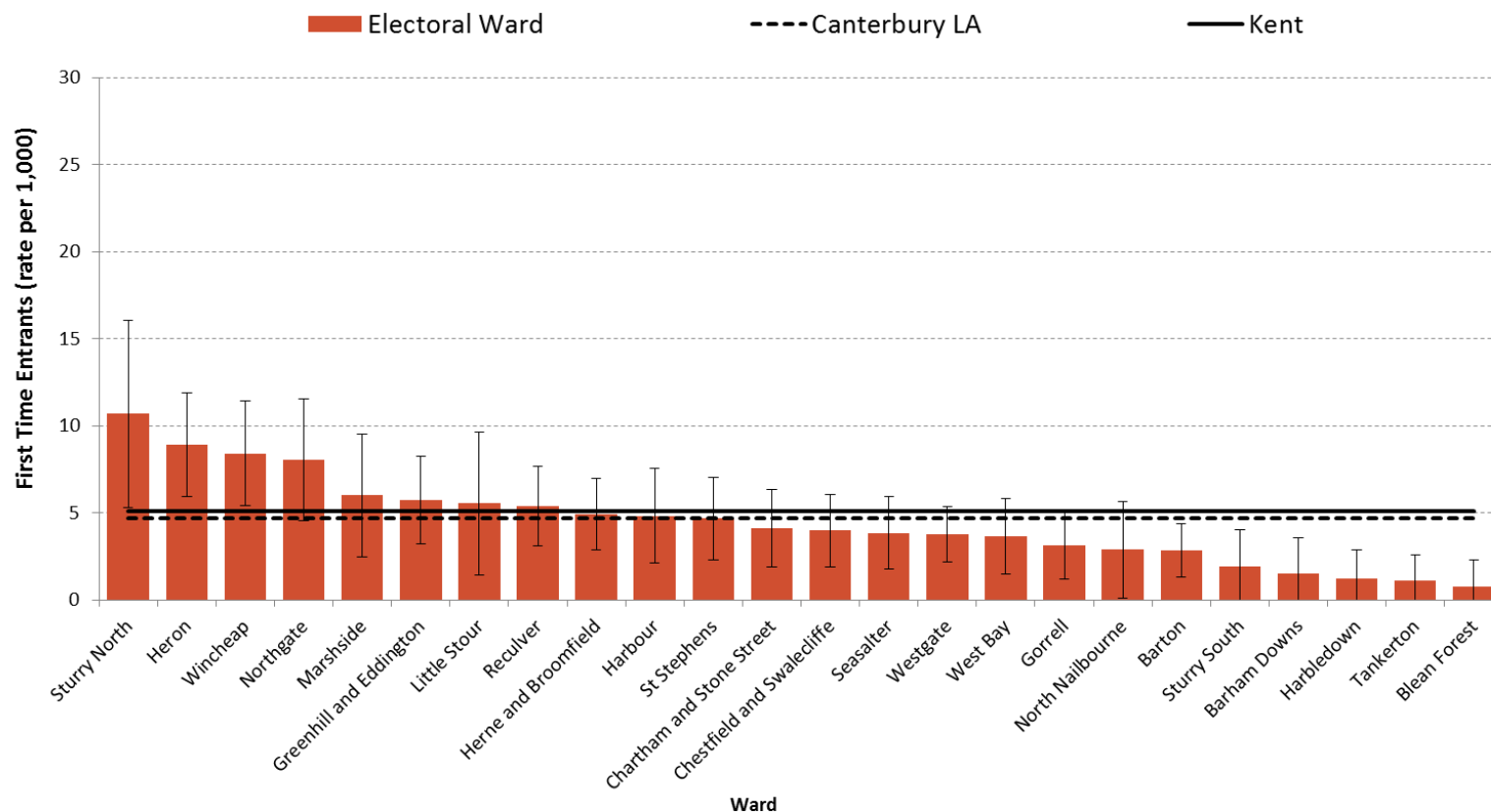
First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System: Ashford

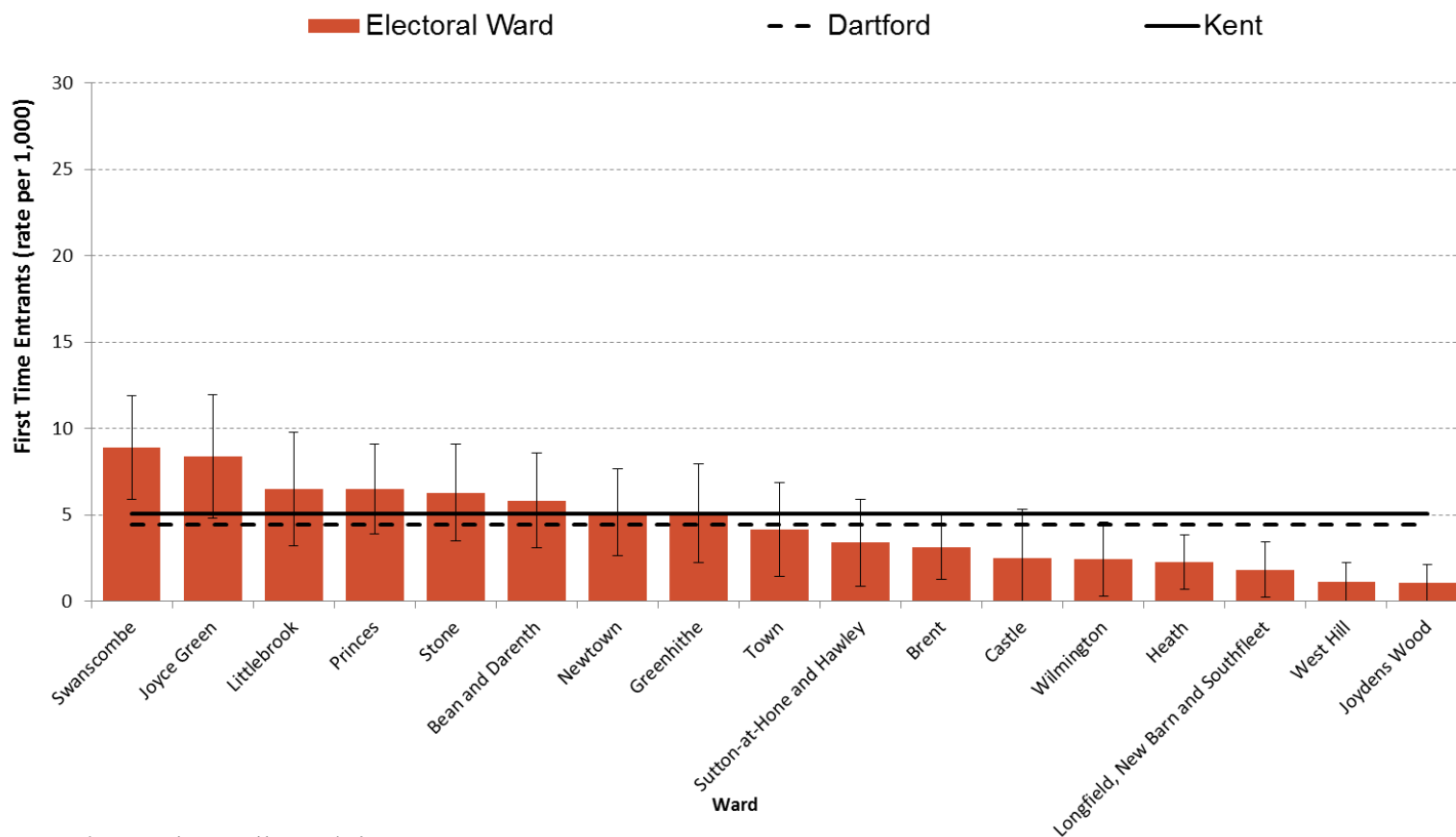
First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System: Canterbury 2011/12-2015/16 pooled

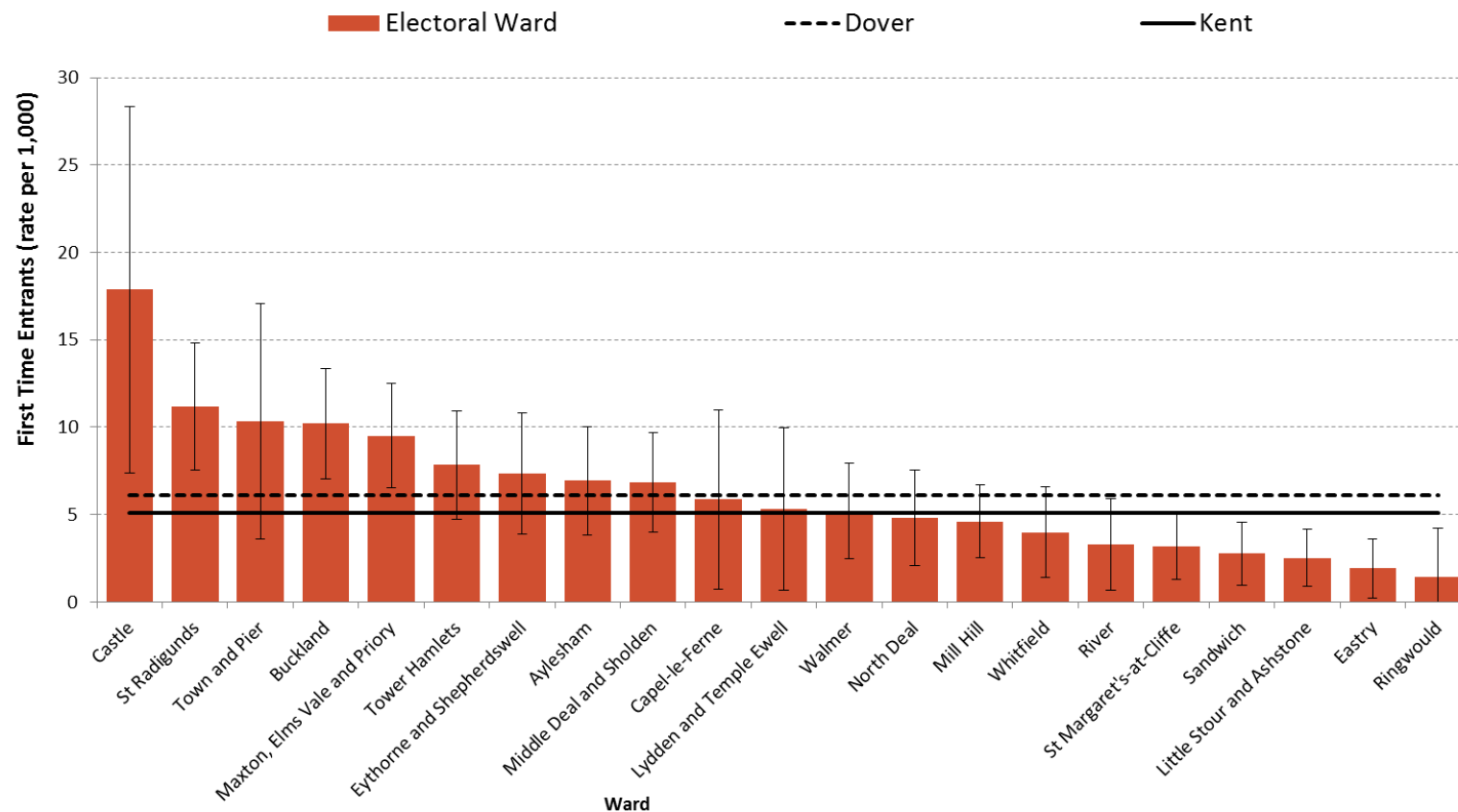
First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System: Dartford 2011/12-2015/16 pooled

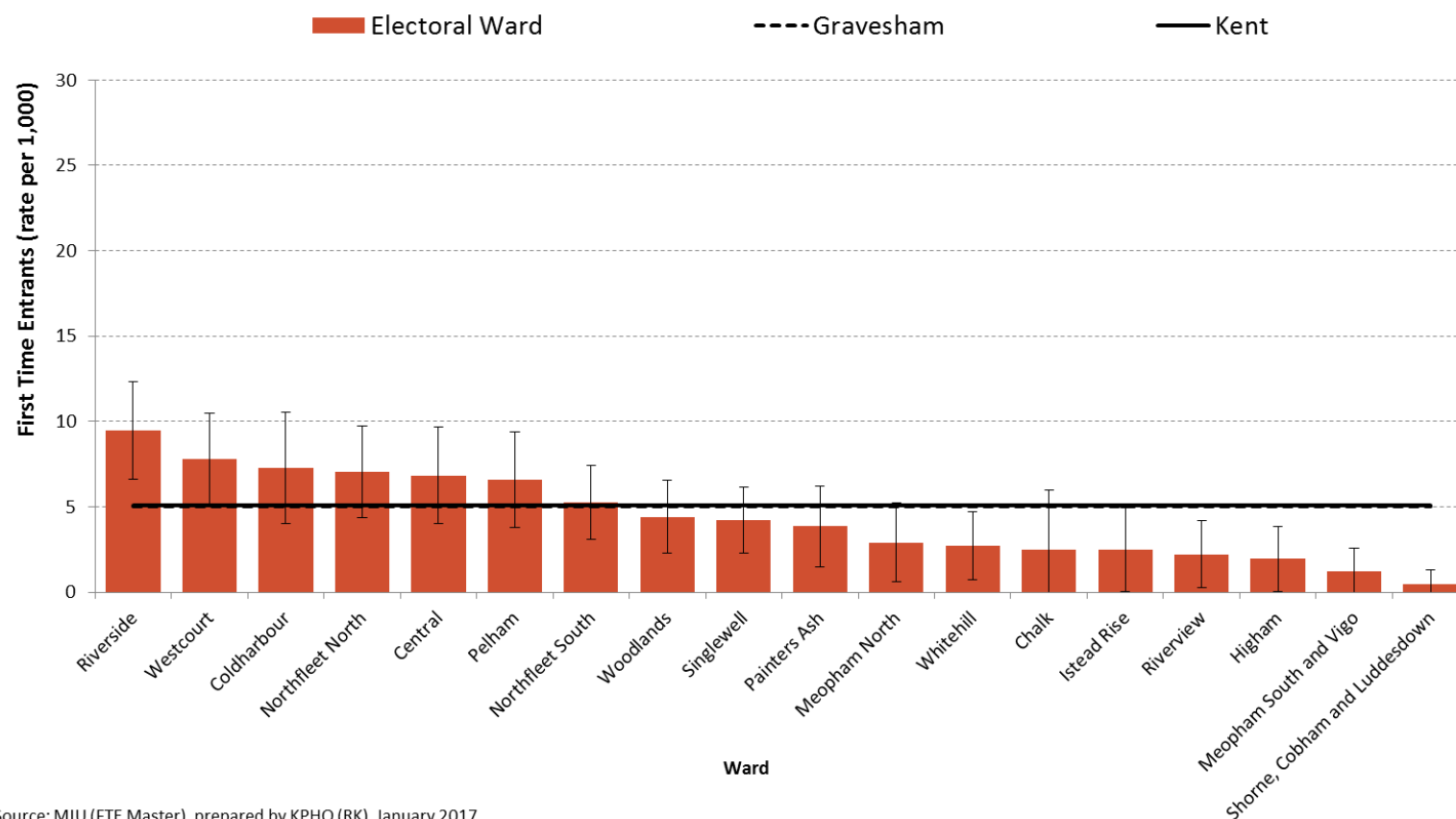
First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System: Dover 2011/12-2015/16 pooled

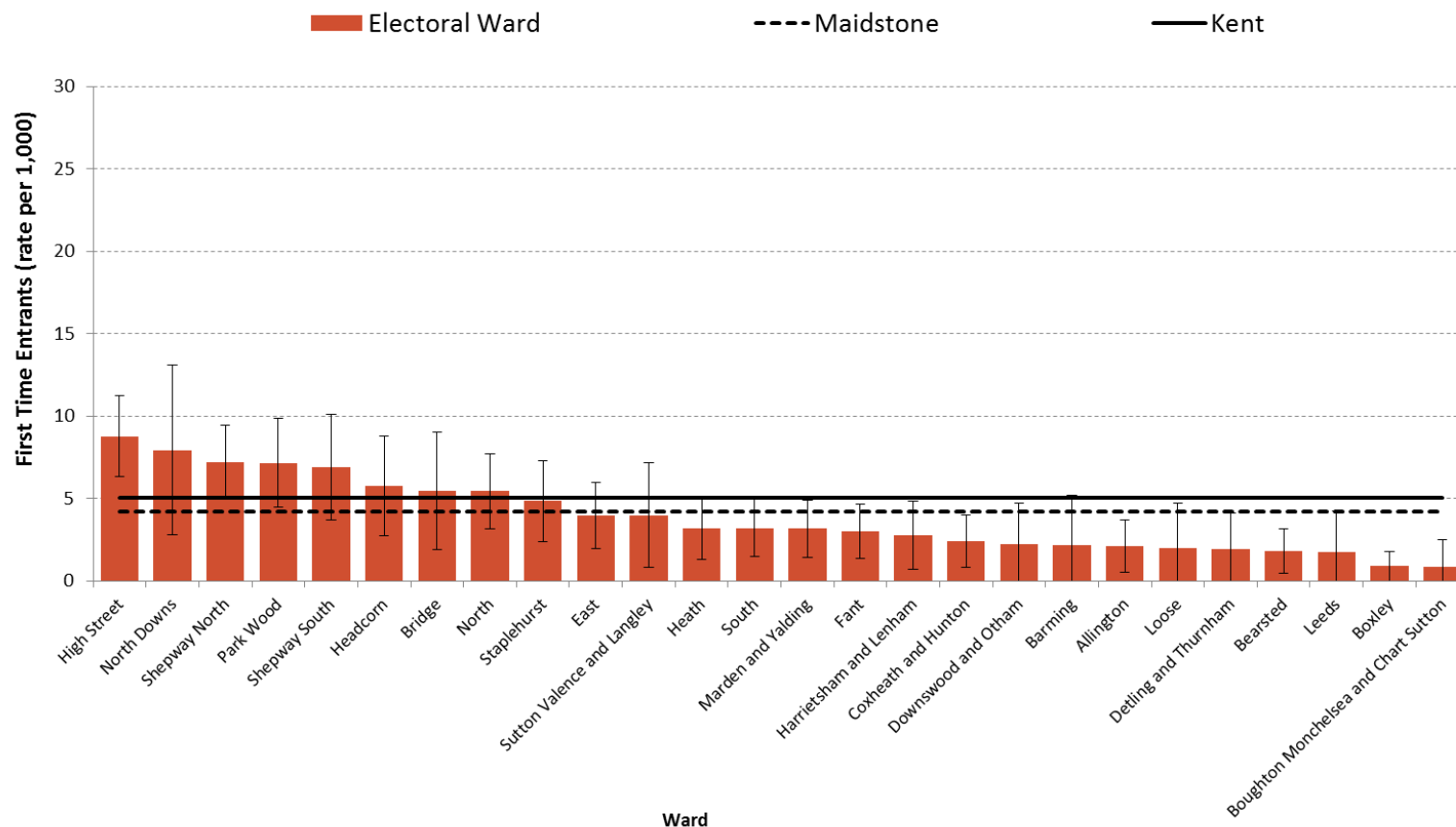
First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System: Gravesham 2011/12-2015/16 pooled

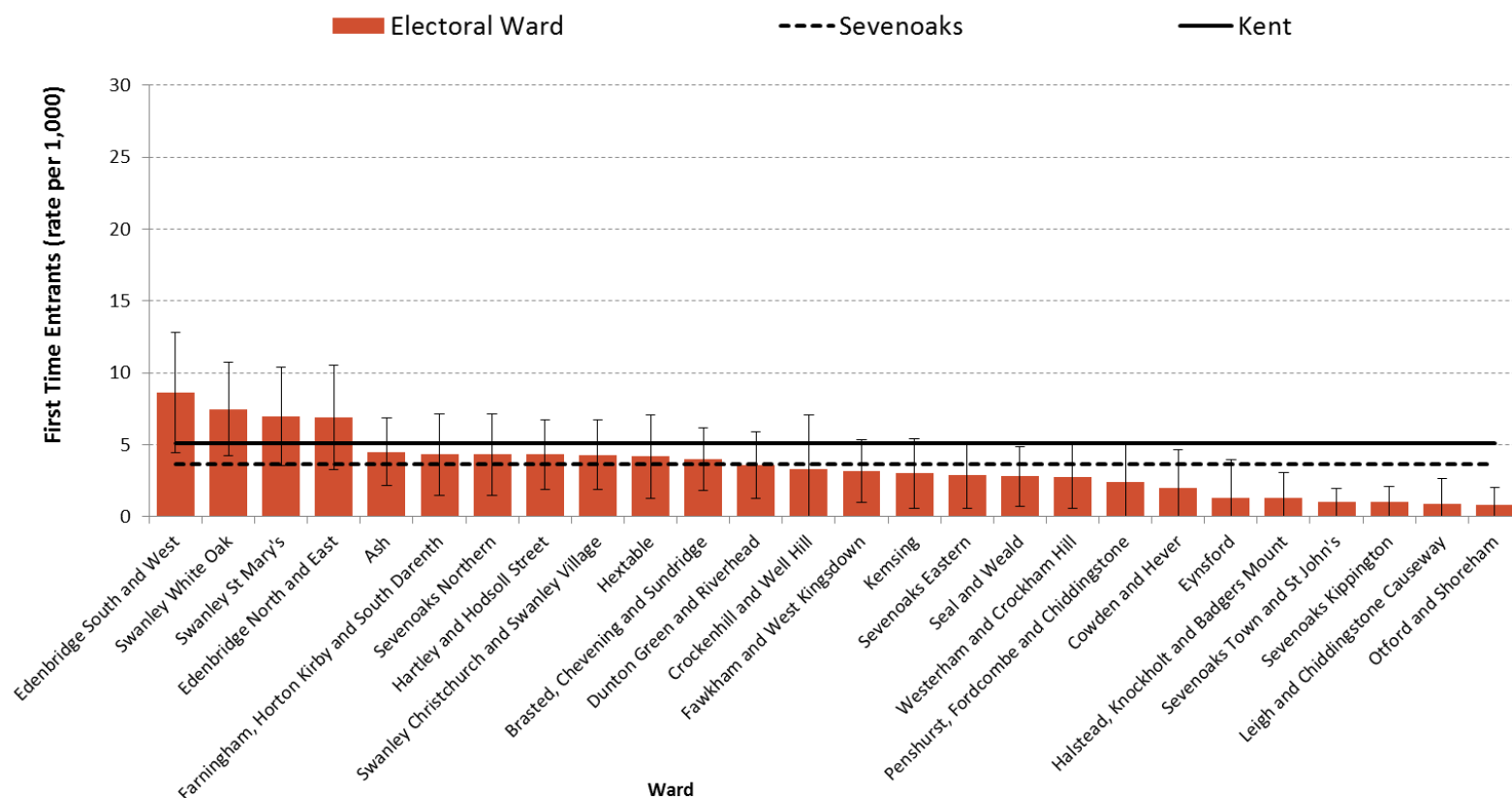

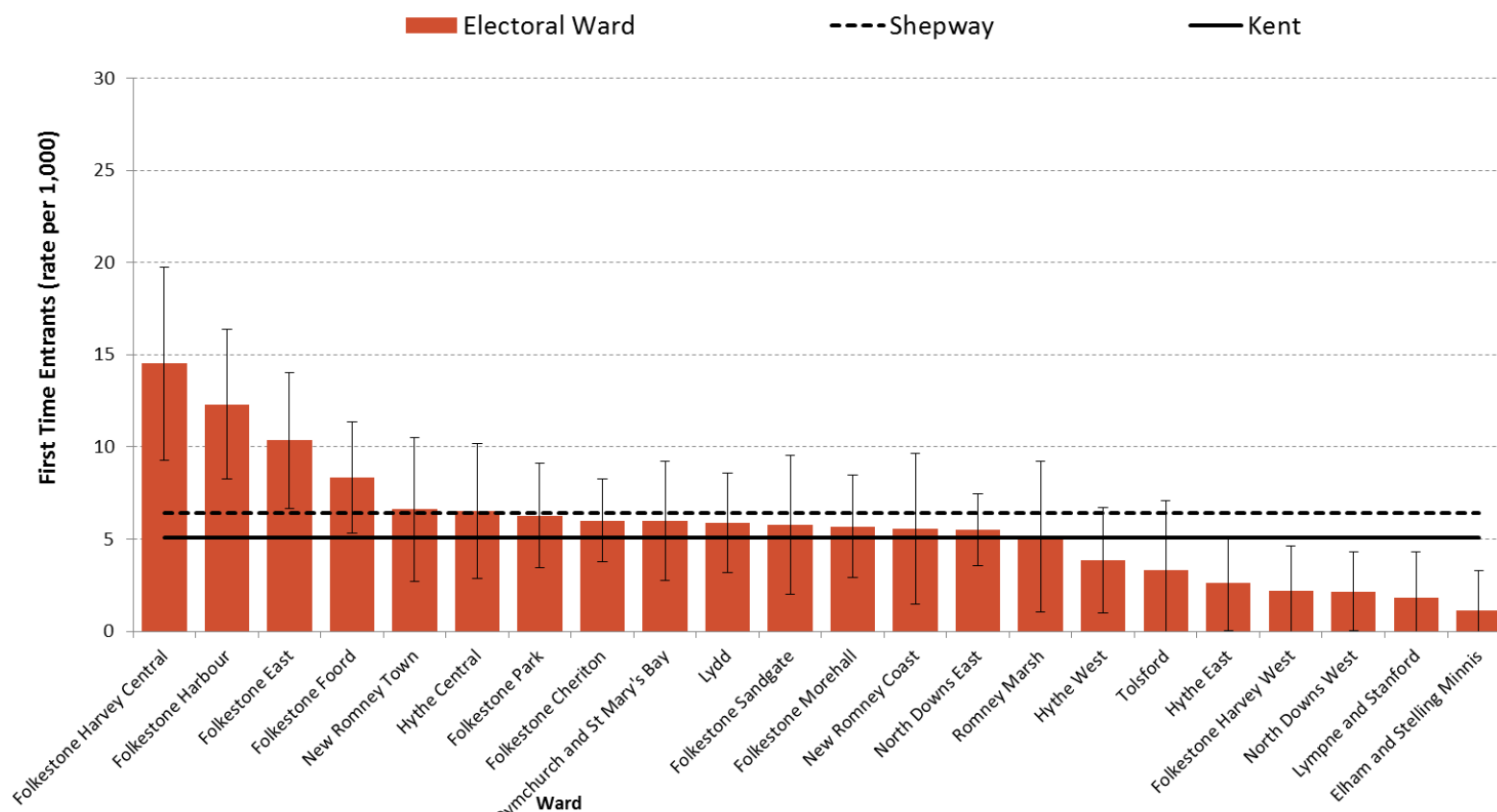
First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System: Sevenoaks 2011/12-2015/16 pooled

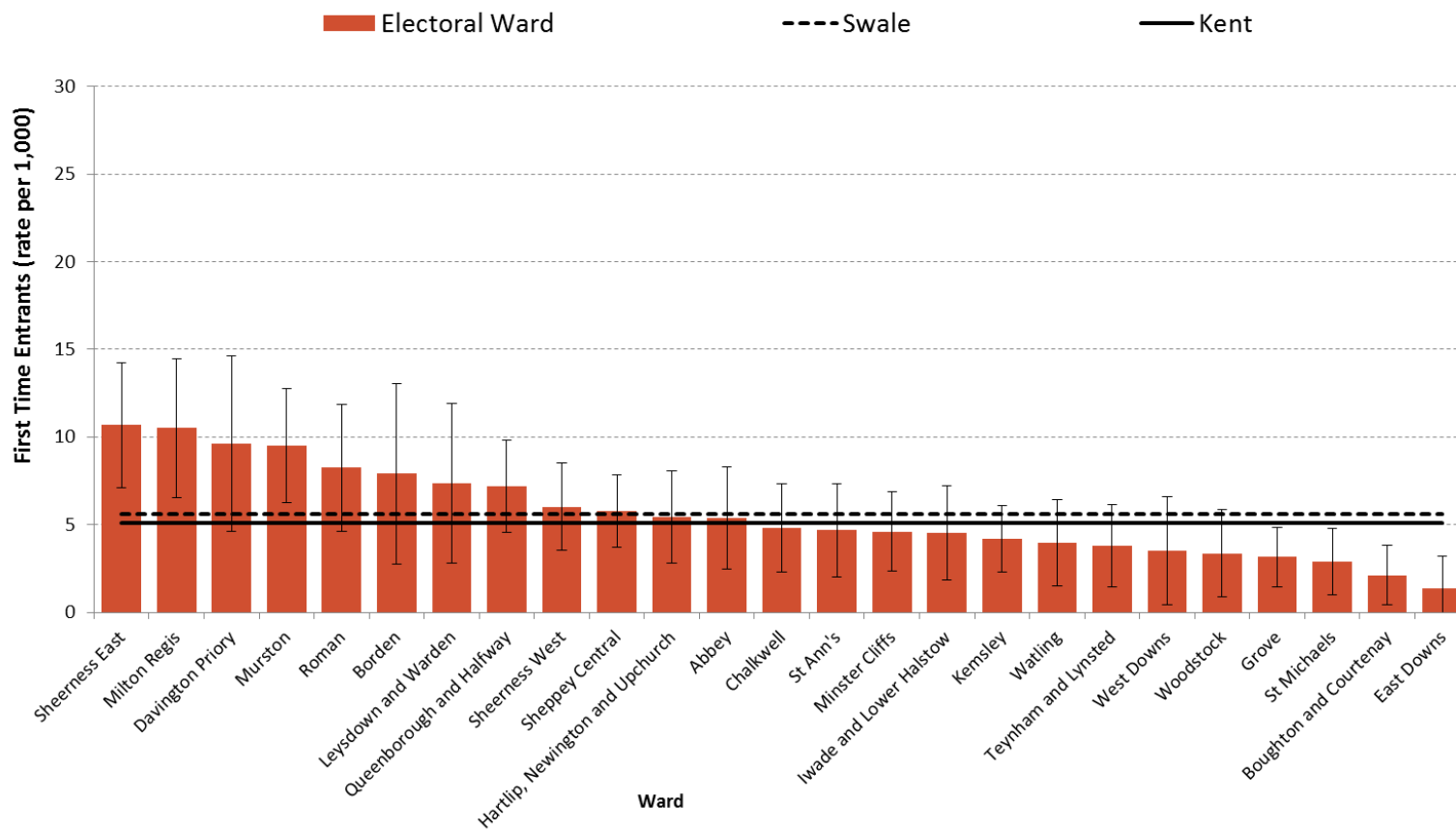
First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System: Shepway 2011/12-2015/16 pooled

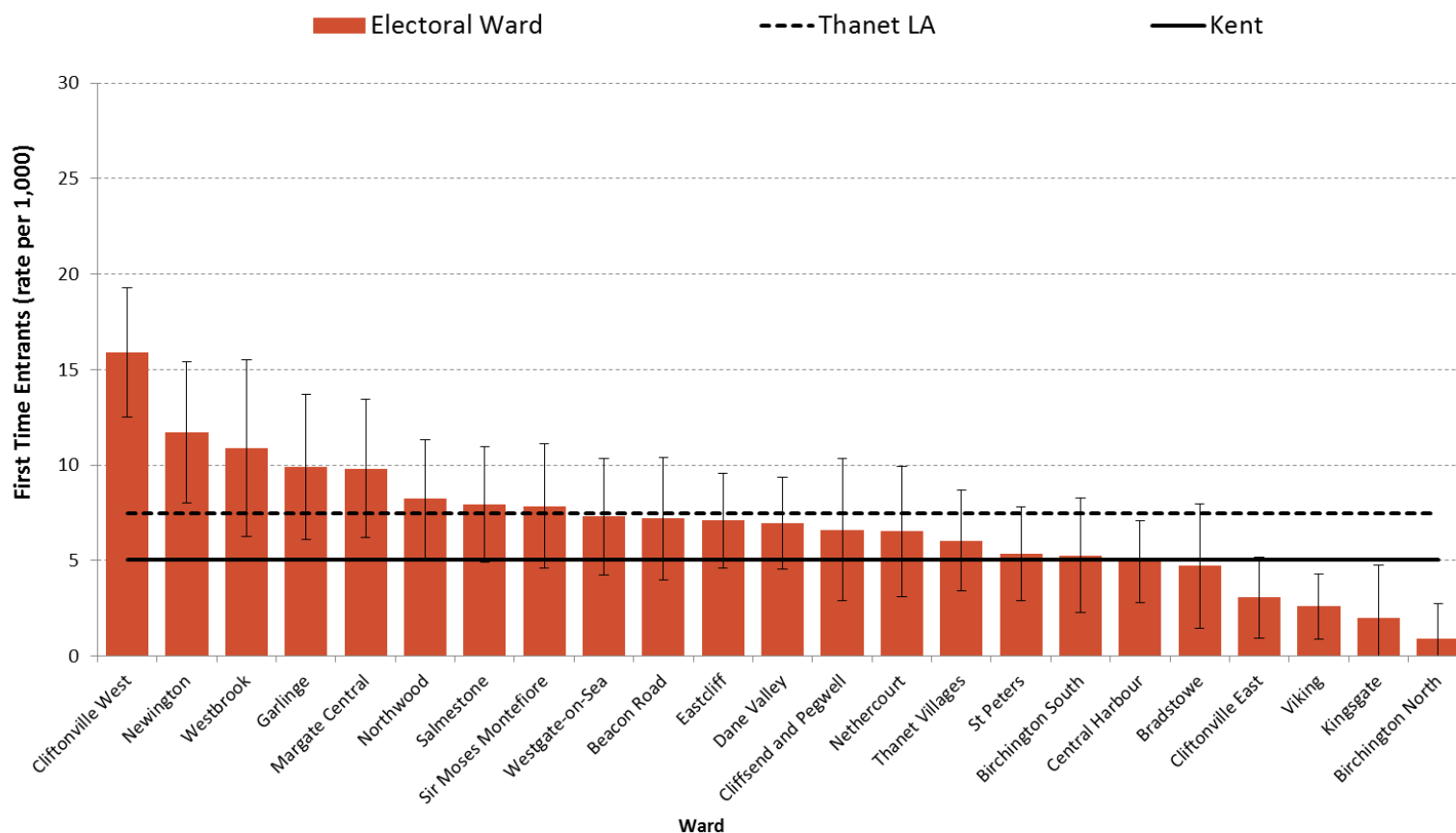

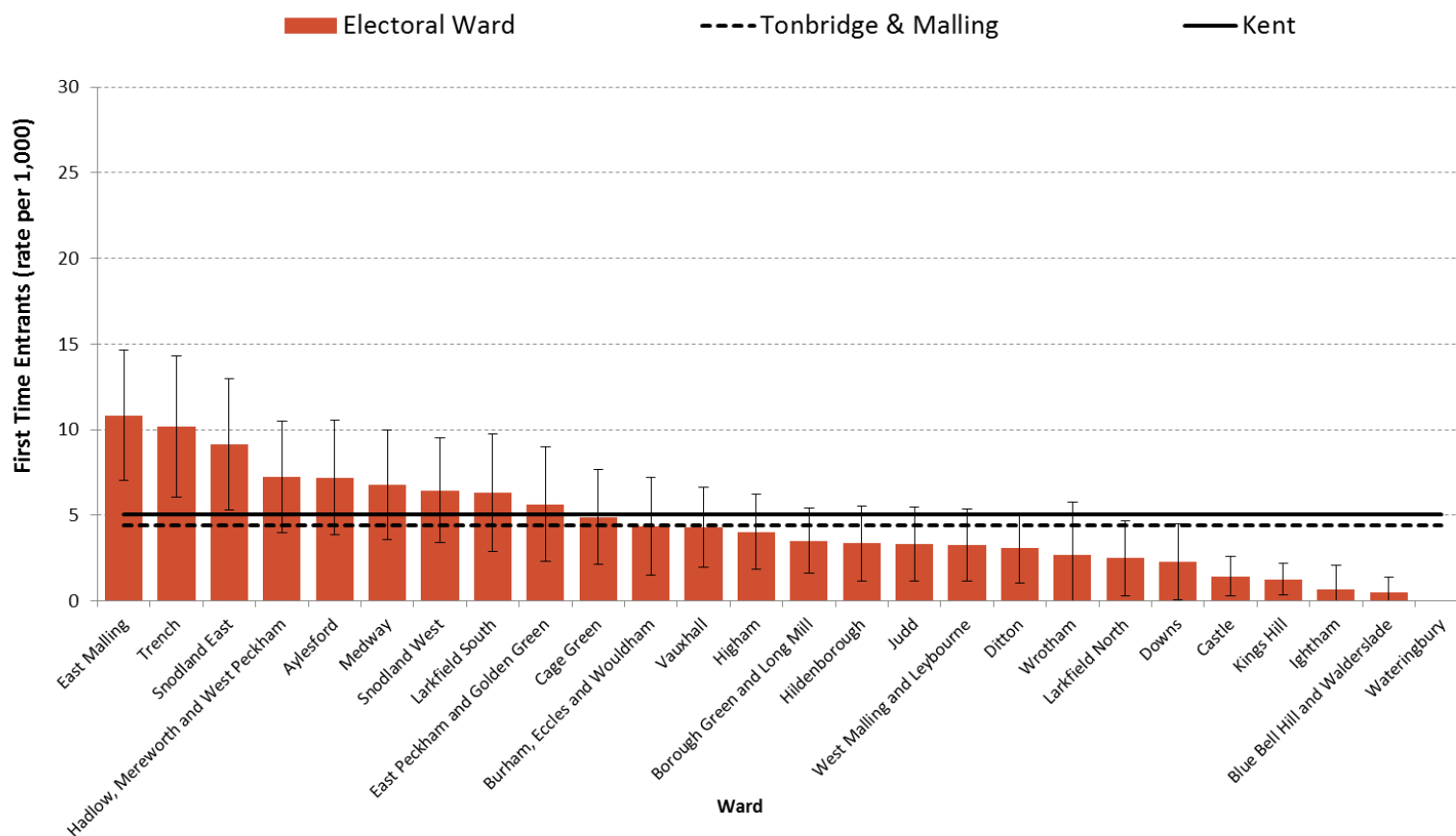
First Time Entrants to the Youth Justice System: Thanet 2011/12-2015/16 pooled

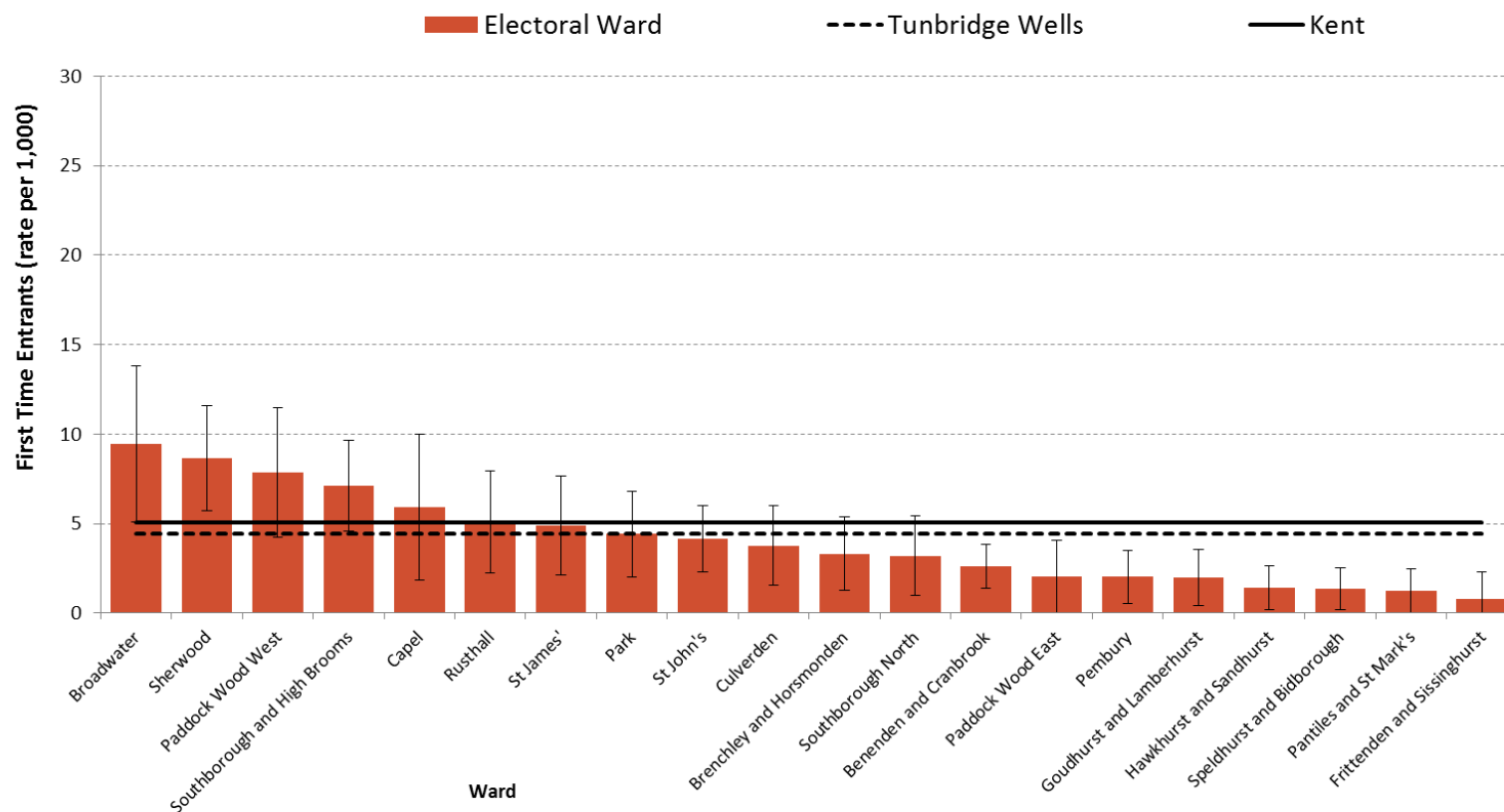
