1. Key findings

Dane Valley electoral ward is amongst the 20% most deprived in Kent County and parts of the area rank among the 2% most deprived in England. There are considerably more, younger people aged under 15 than is typical of the Thanet district council area. As with the rest of east Kent, the highest proportion of the population is white British but from 2001 to 2011 there was almost a doubling in the percentage ethnic population of Thanet.

Thanet had a higher all age, all cause mortality rate than both Kent and England. Key killers for in Dane Valley are circulatory disease, cancer and respiratory disease. Dane Valley ward had a lower all age, all cause mortality rate than Kent; however, increases have been observed over the past three years. Under 75 cancer, circulatory and respiratory disease mortality rates based on 2011-2015 pooled data were higher in Dane Valley than Kent and Thanet.

Life expectancy in Dane Valley is slightly higher than the Thanet life expectancy. Across Thanet, there is a 17.1 year spread in life expectancy between the lowest and highest wards. Individually, male and female life expectancies in Dane Valley are both higher than Thanet and Kent,

Smoking prevalence in Dane Valley ward is more than 30% of the population. In 2014/15, a rate of 42.2 per 1,000 people in Dane Valley set a quit date and 19.7 per 1,000 population had a validated quit using a carbon monoxide tester four weeks later.

Dane Valley has a lower admission rate for chronic alcoholic liver disease and alcohol specific admissions than both Thanet, and higher admissions for mental and behavioural disorders than Kent. There is a higher mental health contact rate for people aged 16 to 64 than Thanet, at 49.0 contacts per 1,000 population. Approximately 4% of all referrals to secondary mental health services emanate from Dane Valley area in 2015/16.

In Dane Valley ward, the rate of teenage pregnancy has decreased by 4% between 2009/11 and 2012/14. Millmead Children's Centre has a higher 6-8 week breastfeeding prevalence rate than Thanet, at 37%.

Obesity and overweight levels in reception year children in Dane Valley (35%) are higher than those of Thanet district (23%) and Kent County (22%) as a whole. In the larger area of Thanet about 34% of year six children are classified as overweight or obese which is similar to the Kent average (31%). Within Dane Valley, this figure is lower, at 31%.

Screening rates vary between practices within the district. Breast screening uptake in Thanet practices is lower than county average in many cases.



In 2015/16, there were 470.00 A&E attendances per 1,000 population in Dane Valley, a higher rate than Thanet which had 392.89 attendances per 1,000 population. This has remained fairly stable since 2013/14. Across Thanet, a quarter (24.88%) of the population attended A&E in 2015/16, while a higher proportion (29.38%) of the population of Dane Valley attended A&E. Of those who attended, 34.42% of the Dane Valley residents attended multiple times, compared to 31.00% of Thanet residents.

2 **Demographic**

2.1 Geography

The electoral ward of Dane Valley is located inland from Margate and Cliftonville on the north eastern coast of the Isle of Thanet.

2.3 Age Structure

The age structure of the Dane Valley area differs from that of Thanet, Kent County and England with considerably higher proportions of young people aged 0-14. This differs from the local structure for Thanet overall, which has a considerably older population than national levels, in that 22% of Thanet's population is aged 65+, compared to 18% for the rest of the country. In contrast, 16% of Dane Valley's population are aged 65 and over.

Figure 2.3.1 Age Structure of Dane Valley Ward Compared to Thanet, KCC and England







Figure 2.3.2 Age Profile for Dane Valley Ward – number of resident population, 2014



2.4 Ethnicity

As with the rest of east Kent, the highest proportion of the population of Dane Valley ward is white British. The ethnic mix of the population and population totals are shown in Table 2.4.1. Ethnicity data are old because they are derived from the 2011 census but they are the most up to date at this level.



Figure 2.4.1 shows ethnicity at district authority level as measured by the 2011 census. These estimates do have drawbacks as figures are rounded and they appear to have amalgamated groups such as 'Chinese' with 'Other'. Even with these drawbacks and their lack of availability at ward level, they are of interest because they indicate that the percentage of ethnic residents in Thanet district has risen from 2.5% in 2001 to 4.5% in 2011. This may reflect an increase in migration from eastern Europe as increases in proportions of those of 'other ethnic origin' have occurred between the two census periods.

2.5 Deprivation

The Indices of Multiple Deprivation are constructed using 36 variables across seven domains. These domains are income, barriers to housing, health and disability, crime, education, living environment and employment. Scores are present at lower super output areas (LSOAs). LSOAs areas are constructed using populations from communities or naturally bounded areas. The number of people in an LSOA is between 1,000 and 1,500 and they are aggregated together to form electoral wards. The number of LSOAs in an electoral ward can vary from one to five depending upon the original size of the electoral ward. The figure below shows that the areas with the highest deprivation are around central Margate, Cliftonville West, Dane Valley, Eastcliff and Newington.




Figure 2.5.1 Map of relative deprivation status by electoral ward, 2015

Mortality 3

3.1 Mortality from All Causes, All Ages

Across east Kent, illnesses such as coronary heart disease, cancer and respiratory conditions continue to contribute most significantly to mortality.

The directly standardised all age, all cause mortality rate in 2012-14 in the Thanet district is among the highest in Kent County and above the England rate. Differences in the age and sex of the population of Thanet have been included in the calculation of the mortality rate in this graph. The high rate is therefore due to other, most likely socio-economic, factors.




Figure 3.1.1 All age, all cause mortality rates, 2012 to 2014 (Pooled)

All age, all cause mortality is lower in Dane Valley than in Thanet district and Kent county overall. Because of statistically low numbers of events (relative to population size), electoral ward mortality rates can fluctuate substantially year-on-year, but the district authority and county rates are more robust, making them useful as comparators.

In the 2011-2015 time period, there were 8,348 deaths in Thanet and the age standardised rate (ASR) was 1049.5 per 100,000 residents. Dane Valley's mortality rate was 910.9 per 100,000 residents, lower than both Thanet and Kent.



Thanet has a downward all age, all cause mortality trend between 2006 and 2015. Comparative mortality rates for Dane Valley tend to be slightly lower than the Thanet figures, but also show a downward trajectory. However, since 2013, all age, all cause mortality for Dane Valley has been increasing.

Based on pooled data for 2011 to 2015; the main causes of death in Dane Valley were cancer (33.9%), circulatory disease (27.7%) and respiratory diseases (17.6%). Within circulatory disease, 56.3% were due to ischaemic heart disease and 16.3% due to stroke. For cancer deaths, the site with the most deaths was lung (26.5%).


3.2 Mortality from Cancer in the Under 75s

There were 1,054 cancer deaths in Thanet at age 74 or under during the period of 2011 to 2015. Although Dane Valley did not have the highest rates in Thanet, mortality rates were among the highest and above the Thanet and Kent rates.


3.3 Mortality from All Circulatory Diseases in the Under 75s

There were 571 deaths from circulatory disease in Thanet at age 74 or under during the period of 2011-15, with an approximate male - female ratio of 2:1. Dane Valley had a rate of 101.1 deaths from circulatory disease per 100,000 population aged under 75, higher, but not significantly higher than Kent (70.4), and Thanet (88.6).



3.5 Summary

- Thanet had a higher all age, all cause mortality rate than both Kent and England.
- Key killers for this population are circulatory disease, cancer and respiratory disease.
- Dane Valley ward had a lower all age, all cause mortality rate than Kent; however, increases have been observed over the past three years.
- Under 75 cancer, circulatory and respiratory disease mortality rates based on 2011 2015 pooled data were higher in Dane Valley than Kent and Thanet.

4 Life Expectancy

4.1 Life Expectancy at Birth


Life expectancy in Thanet is 78.0 for males and 82.5 for women, with an average of 80.3 for both sexes. This is significantly lower than the Kent average life expectancy of 81.8 years. Dane Valley electoral ward has a life expectancy of 82.0 years, higher than Thanet and Kent (81.8). Individually, male and female life expectancies in Dane Valley are both higher than Thanet and Kent, at 78.8 and 85.4 respectively. For this time period, 2011-2015, the difference, i.e. the health inequality, just across the wards in Thanet is 17.1 years.

- Life expectancy in Dane Valley is slightly higher than the Thanet life expectancy.
- Individually, male and female life expectancy in Dane Valley are both higher than Thanet and Kent,
- There is a 17.1 year spread between the lowest and highest wards in Thanet district.

5 Lifestyle Contributors to Health Inequalities

This section provides an analysis of some of the key lifestyle contributors to health inequalities.

5.1 Smoking

Although cigarette smoking prevalence in England is typically declining, smoking prevalence in Dane Valley ward is more than 30% of the population.

5.2 Substance Misuse

Data from the following tables show hospital admissions for chronic alcoholic liver disease, inpatient hospital alcohol admissions and hospital admissions for mental and behavioural disorders due to psychoactive substance use. Generally, Dane Valley has lower admission rates in comparison to other wards in Thanet.

There are currently a range of drug and alcohol services within the Thanet area, which are delivered by two providers: Turning Point, deliver a variety of drug and alcohol treatment for adults, whereas Addaction deliver treatment services for young people.

Dane Valley ward (88.9) had a significantly lower admission rate than Kent (118.9) for chronic alcoholic liver disease based on 2011/12 to 2015/16 pooled data.



5.3 Mental Health

In Dane Valley, 49.0 individuals contacted mental health services run by Kent and Medway Partnership trust in 2015. The contact rate across Thanet was 39.1 per 1,000 population aged 16 to 64.

In different areas, people are more or less likely to suffer with mental illnesses. To some extent this can be predicted from characteristics of the population measured by the census or other types of survey. Mental health needs indices estimate by how much. The Mental illness needs index (MINI2000) is an index or ratio calculated as the predicted admission rate for the area divided by the predicted admission rate for England. A needs index of 0.8 suggests that there will be 20% less illness in an area than in the country as a whole, an index of 1.2 suggests 20% more.

Dane Valley ward is expected to have an admissions rate for mental illness of 20% of more above the national rate.





Figure 5.3.3 Mental Illness Needs Index by Ward in Thanet

In 2015/16, 4.45% of all appointments to secondary mental health services in Thanet generated from a GP referral emanated from the Dane Valley area.







5.4 Teenage Conceptions

Past data tell us that women from poorer backgrounds are more likely to become mothers as teenagers. Teenage pregnancy reflects limited aspirations and often culturally determined notions of self-worth. It is important to aim to reduce teenage conceptions because evidence suggests that teenage mothers and their children face poorer social, economic and health outcomes than their older peers. Clinically, such outcomes include an increased risk of premature birth, low birth weight and infant death. A high teenage conception rate in an area with existing deprivation makes it more difficult to break the cycle of health inequalities.

Since the 1998 time period, teenage conceptions in Thanet have dropped by 48% with a considerable decrease within the last four years. In Dane Valley ward, the rate of teenage pregnancy has decreased by 4% since 2009/11. This may be due to a combination of factors including:

- Better joined up services between the community midwives, sexual health outreach nurses and the Children's Centres.
- Sexual Health Outreach nurses have been targeting reduction in second teenage conceptions.
- Rate of Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) administration in Thanet is above the Kent average.

Figure 5.4.1 Under 18 Conception Rates and Percentages Leading to Abortion in Thanet District Authority, 1998 to 2014




Figure 5.4.1 Under 18 Conception rates by electoral ward in Thanet, 2012-2014 (pooled)

Teenage conceptions, 2012-2014 (pooled)



5.5 Childhood Weight

Obesity and overweight levels in reception year children in Dane Valley (35%) are higher than those of Thanet district (23%) and Kent County (22%) as a whole.

In the larger area of Thanet about 34% of year six children are classified as overweight or obese which is similar to the Kent average (31%). Within Dane Valley, this figure comparable, at 31%.



5.6 Breastfeeding

The data at Millmead Children's Centre level shows that the prevalence of breastfeeding in Dane Valley is above the Thanet prevalence, at 37%. The coverage rate should be at least 95%, so there is a need to focus on ensuring that this is increased.

Figure 5.7.1 Bowel Screening Uptake by Practice in Thanet District, 2014/15





Figure 5.7.2 Bowel Screening Coverage by Practice in Thanet District, 2014/15








Figure 5.7.5 Cervical Screening Coverage by Practice in Thanet District, 2014/15

5.8 Summary

- Smoking prevalence in Dane Valley ward is more than 30% of the population. In 2014/15, a rate of 42.2 per 1,000 people in Dane Valley set a quit date and 19.7 per 1,000 population had a validated quit using a carbon monoxide tester four weeks later.
- Dane Valley has a lower admission rate for chronic alcoholic liver disease and alcohol specific admissions than both Thanet, and higher admissions for mental and behavioural disorders than Kent.
- Dane Valley had a higher mental health contact rate for people aged 16 to 64 than Thanet, at 49.0 contacts per 1,000 population. Approximately 4% of all referrals to secondary mental health services emanate from Dane Valley area in 2015/16.
- In Dane Valley ward, the rate of teenage pregnancy has decreased by 4% between 2009/11 and 2012/14.
- Obesity and overweight levels in reception year children in Dane Valley (35%) are higher than those of Thanet district (23%) and Kent County (22%) as a whole.
- In the larger area of Thanet about 34% of year six children are classified as overweight or obese which is similar to the Kent average (31%). Within Dane Valley, this figure is lower, at 31%.
- Millmead Children's Centre has a higher 6-8 week breastfeeding prevalence rate than Thanet, at 37%.
- Screening rates vary between practices within the district. Breast screening uptake in Thanet practices is lower than county average in many cases.

In 2015/16, there were 470.00 A&E attendances per 1,000 population in Dane Valley, a higher rate than Thanet which had 392.89 attendances per 1,000 population.

6.2 Summary
